## 1. Touring Difficulty – Is This Tour Right for You?

Before registration, please consider this important information:

- While touring, you will be boarding and getting off the vehicle several times per day.
- Some of the days will entail several hours of walking on even and uneven pavements or roads, ascending and descending stairs (sometimes without railings), walking up or down hills, or standing in place for 30-60 minutes at a time, while listening to the guide's explanations.
- We regret that this tour is not suitable for guests with mobility limitations. The tour staff is not medically trained and cannot provide any assistance with traveler mobility.
- Vehicles, hotels and sites visited on this tour are not ADA-compliant.
- Some of the days may entail drives of 3 hours or longer with breaks every 2 hours.
- You may skip touring days. There will be no refund for unused services, entrance fees or meals.
- May – September daytime temperatures in Greece can be higher than 100°F (38°C).
- Food allergies or requirements will be forwarded but may not be properly addressed. It is the responsibility of the participants to be diligent about their food.

## 7. Not Included in the Tour or Package Cost:

- Generally speaking: Any service or tour component not mentioned above as included, is not included. This refers to any **airfare**, touring and meals not part of the itinerary, drinks during meals, passports, visas, expenses of a personal nature such as gifts, mini-bar purchases or cell phone expenses (calls, data roaming).
- **Flights: please do not purchase your flights until requested to do so.**
- **Travel insurance.**
- **Tips: Approximately €120 for hotels staff, transfer and bus drivers and guides.**
- **Climate Resilience Tax to be paid directly to each hotel: €15 per room per night in Athens and €10 per room per night in Olympia and Delphi.**

## 8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By registering and paying, you signify that you represent the travel party and have read, understand, and agree to all sections of this brochure and Disclaimer below.
- B. Important dates to remember:**
- a. **Upon Registration:** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person.
  - b. **45 Days Prior to Arrival in Athens:** Final payment is due and is non-refundable.
- C. Refund periods (if you cancel):**
- a. Cancel within 1 day of reservation: Fully refundable.
  - b. Cancel 46 days or more prior to arrival in Athens: \$100 per person is non-refundable.
  - c. Cancel 45 days or less prior to arrival in Athens: All payments are non-refundable.
- D. Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC or Force Majeure:**
- a. In the event a specific tour departure needs to be cancelled due to insufficient registration (for the bus tour) payments will be refunded or applied towards other services.
  - b. Should the tour be cancelled due to reasons or events beyond the control of Scopia LLC (force majeure): Scopia LLC will work with tour suppliers for possible reimbursement of payments made to the suppliers. Amounts received by Scopia LLC will be reimbursed to tour participants less \$200 per person to cover time and expenses by Scopia LLC.
- E. Important note:** Payment and refund schedule and/or amounts may change if certain suppliers require deposits (refundable or non-refundable) which are not listed above.
- F. Shared bus tour (outside of Athens) is operated by Chat Tours in Greece, whose [Terms and Conditions](#) apply for this portion of the package.
- G. There is no refund for unused services while traveling.
- H. Scopia LLC has the right to refuse participation to any registrant, for any reason and without the need to disclose such reasoning.
- I. Scopia LLC has the right to cancel reservations made on behalf of participant(s), without refunding payments made, should a participant fail to pay deposits or final payments by the due dates.
- J. Cancellations must be received in writing.
- K. Credit Card Chargebacks - Payments by credit card do not change these Terms and Conditions. Prior to initiating a "chargeback" with the credit card company, please try to resolve any disputes with Scopia LLC directly. In the event of a "Chargeback" investigation finding in favor of Scopia LLC, the customer will be charged a \$100 administrative fee for each "Chargeback".
- L. Credit card refunds do not include the 3% agency processing fee.
- M. Insurance costs are not reimbursed by the insurance company in case of cancellation(s) and filing of a claim due to a covered reason.

Flights are not included in the package costs. Please do not book your flights before being requested to do so. You can purchase tickets yourself or with the help of Scopia LLC, departing the US for Athens 1 day before the listed package start date. Private airport transfers are included in the tour costs. Transfers for participants arriving/departing on the same date and flight may be combined.
