# 1. Touring Difficulty – Is This Tour Right for You?

The tour is not sold or offered as ADA-compliant. Aside from the beautiful sites and lots of fun on the tour, there is important information you should consider:

- Although porterage service will be provided, you may need to carry your luggage on occasion.
- Some of the days will entail bus rides of 2-4 hours (planned bathroom breaks).
- You will be boarding and getting off the bus 4-6 times per day, during touring days.
- Some of the days will entail several hours of walking on even and uneven pavements or roads, ascending and descending stairs (without railings), walking up or down hills, or standing in place for 20-30 minutes at a time, while listening to the guide's explanations.
- Many of the sites are not designed to accommodate travelers with walking accessories.
- The buses on the tour are not ADA-compliant and may not have bathrooms.
- It is possible to skip sites and stay in the hotel, with no refund for unused entrance fees.
- Temperatures will likely be in the 60's-70's during the daytime, depending on location. Evenings will likely be in the 50's 60's. It may be colder in mountains areas, along with rain on occasion.
- Morocco is a developing country. It is recommended not to drink tap water and avoid uncooked/unpeeled fruits and vegetables. Smoking may be allowed indoors (hotel lobbies).
- Souvenir peddlers at tourist sites can be a bit intimidating. Learn to say "no".
- Food allergies will be noted and forwarded but may not be properly addressed.
- Medical facilities in Morocco are available in large cities but limited in remote areas.

# 2. To Register for the Tour:

Registration for the tour is now open via the dedicated, secure form available on the tour website.

The upfront pay now costs are \$100 non-refundable deposit per person. It can be paid by check or credit card (with a fee). This deposit will be refunded if a minimum of 10 participants is not reached by November 15, 2025.

#### Please have the following information/documents available prior to registration:

- Your passport (must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of return).
  - If you do not have a passport or if your passport expires prior to September 30, 2026, please apply for a new passport.
- Your TTP or Global Entry number (optional)
- Your Delta or partner airline frequent flyer number (optional)

**Seller of Travel:** A reminder that Scopia LLC **is not** registered as a "Seller of Travel" in the states of California, Washington and Iowa. This tour is therefore not offered to residents of the states unless the tour is fully paid for as a gift by someone from another state.

## 7. Travel Insurance:

# 8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By paying, you signify that you represent the travel party and have read, understood, and agree to all sections of this brochure and Disclaimer below.
- B. Payments are only accepted by check, wire transfer or Zelle, except for the initial deposits which can be paid by credit card, with an added 3% agency handling fee.
- C. Check payments should be sent to arrive by the due date to Scopia LLC, 8916 N Iroquois Road, Bayside, WI 53217. Please add "Spain/Morocco March 2026" to the memo line.

#### D. Important dates to remember:

- a. **Upon Registration and no later than November 15, 2025:** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person (credit card or check). This deposit will be reimbursed if we do not have a minimum of 10 participants registered by the deadline.
- b. **November 15, 2025:** If we reach 10 participants, a second non-refundable deposit of \$2,700 per person is due (check, wire transfer or Zelle).
- c. **February 1, 2026:** Final payment is due and is non-refundable (check, wire transfer or Zelle).

#### E. Refund periods (if you cancel):

- a. Cancel by November 14, 2025: \$100 cancellation fee per person.
- b. Cancel from November 15, 2025 to January 31, 2026: \$1,800 cancellation fee per person.
- c. Cancel any time after February 1, 2026: All payments are non-refundable.

#### F. Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC:

- a. In the event the tour needs to be cancelled by November 15, 2025 due to lack of registrations, all deposits will be refunded in full.
- b. Should the tour be cancelled due to reasons or events beyond the control of Scopia LLC (force majeure): Scopia LLC will work with tour suppliers for possible reimbursement of payments made to the suppliers. Amounts received by Scopia LLC will be reimbursed to tour participants, less a fee of \$300 per person to cover time and expenses by Scopia LLC.
- G. Important note: Payment and refund schedule and/or amounts may change if certain suppliers require deposits (refundable or non-refundable) which are not listed above.
- H. There is no refund for unused services while traveling.
- I. Scopia LLC has the right to refuse participation to any registrant, for any reason and without the need to disclose such reasoning.
- J. Scopia LLC has the right to cancel reservations made on behalf of participant(s), without refunding payments made, should a participant fail to pay deposits or final payments by the due dates.
- K. Cancellations must be received in writing.
- L. Credit Card Chargebacks Payments by credit card do not change these Terms and Conditions. Prior to initiating a "chargeback" with the credit card company, please try to resolve any disputes with Scopia LLC directly. In the event of a "Chargeback" investigation finding in favor of Scopia LLC, the customer will be charged a \$100 administrative fee for each "Chargeback".
- M. Credit card refunds do not include the 3% agency processing fee.
- N. Insurance costs are not reimbursed by the insurance company in case of cancellation(s) and filing of a claim due to a covered reason.
