1. Touring Difficulty: Moderate. Is this tour right for you?

The tour is not sold or offered as ADA-compliant. Aside from the beautiful sites and lots of fun on the tour, there is important information you should consider before registering for the tour:

- Although portage service is provided, you may need to carry your luggage on occasion.
- You will be boarding and getting off the bus 5-6 times per day, during touring days.
- Some of the days may entail several hours of walking on even and uneven pavements or roads, ascending and descending stairs (without railings), walking up or down hills, or standing in place for 20-30 minutes at a time, while listening to the guide’s explanations.
- Some of the days will entail bus rides of 4-6 hours with bathroom breaks.
- Vehicles, hotels and sites visited on this tour are not ADA-compliant.
- The tour may not be suitable for guests with mobility limitations. The tour staff is not medically trained and cannot provide any assistance with traveler mobility.
- Traveling in the Tyrol Mountains may entail winding roads at high altitudes.
- It is possible to skip sites and stay in the hotel, but there will be no refund for unused entrance fees.
- Normal daytime temperatures are in the 60’s-70’s, while evenings will likely be in the 40’s – 50’s.
- Food allergies will be noted and forwarded but may not be properly addressed.

3. To register for the tour:

Registration for the tour is open via the dedicated, secure tour website. **Please have the following information/documents available prior to registration:**

- Your passport (must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of return).

Seller of Travel: Scopia LLC is not registered as a “Seller of Travel” in the states of California, Hawaii and Washington. We regret this tour cannot be offered to residents of these states.

4. Travel Insurance:

Travel insurance is highly recommended (but not mandatory) to cover unexpected circumstances or expenses. Find more information on the [Scopia LLC website](#).

Offered travel insurance plans provide insurance coverage that only applies during the covered trip. You may have coverage from other sources that provides you with similar benefits but may be subject to different restrictions depending upon your other coverages. 5. Tour Costs:

The tour costs are based on the current exchange rate (Euro/dollar) and may therefore fluctuate a bit at the time of final payment. Tour costs are based on a minimum number of 10 participants and **do not** include airfare.

 - Aug 31 – Sep 04: 4 Nights [Hotel am Konzerthaus](#) or similar – Vienna
 - Sep 04 – Sep 05: 1 Night [Hotel Weitzer](#) or similar – Graz
 - Sep 05 – Sep 07: 2 Nights [Hotel aDLERS](#) or similar – Innsbruck
 - Sep 07 – Sep 09: 2 Nights [Hotel Altstadt](#) or similar - Salzburg
- **Transportation and Touring:**
 - Transfers:
 - Private arrival transfer from Vienna airport or Central Train Station (Stadt Wien).
 - 8 Days of touring with licensed local guides

7. Not Included in the Tour Cost:

- Generally speaking: Anything not mentioned in the “Tour Cost Includes” portion above is not included. This refers to any airfare, touring and meals not part of the itinerary, passports fees, visa to Austria if needed, expenses of a personal nature such as gifts, phone calls, mini-bar purchases, or cell phone expenses (data, roaming, etc.).

8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By registering for this tour and/or submitting any payment, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agree to all sections of this brochure, including the Terms and Conditions and the Disclaimer. You further confirm that, if registering or paying on behalf of any other traveler, you are authorized to do so, and that all travelers are bound by these terms.
- B. Payments are accepted by check or wire transfer payable to Scopia LLC.
- C. Checks must arrive by the due date and should include "Austria 2026" in the memo line. Address: Scopia LLC, 8916 N. Iroquois Road, Bayside, WI 53217.
- D. **Important dates to remember:**
 - a. **Registration Deadline:** July 1, 2026
 - b. **At Registration and no later than July 1, 2026:** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per person (credit card or check).
 - c. **July 1, 2026:** If we reach 10 participants, a second non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 per person is due and is non-refundable (check or ACH).
 - d. **August 1, 2026:** Final payment is due and is non-refundable (check or wire transfer).
- E. **Refund periods (if you cancel):**
 - a. Cancel by June 30: \$100 cancellation fee per person.
 - b. Cancel July 1 – August 1, 2026: \$1,100 cancellation fee per person.
 - c. Cancel any time after August 1, 2026: All payments are non-refundable.
- F. **Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC:**
 - a. If the tour is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, mainland deposit (\$100) is refunded.
 - b. **Force Majeure & Refunds:** If Scopia LLC cancels the tour due to events beyond its reasonable control ("**Force Majeure**"), such as acts of God, war, terrorism, pandemics, or government travel restrictions, Scopia LLC will use diligent efforts to recover funds from third-party Suppliers. Any recovered funds will be returned to participants, less a non-refundable **\$300 administrative fee** per person to cover work already performed.
- G. **Third-Party and Ancillary Expenses:** Scopia LLC is not responsible for any independent expenses, "add-on" services, or ancillary costs incurred by participants in connection with the tour. This includes, but is not limited to, **independently purchased airfare (domestic or international), travel insurance premiums, visa fees, vaccinations, or specialized equipment.** All such expenses are subject strictly to the terms of the specific service providers, and Scopia LLC shall have no liability for refunds or compensation for these external costs.
- H. **Payment schedules and refund amounts are subject to change if required by suppliers.**
- I. There are no refunds for unused services.
- J. Scopia LLC reserves the right to refuse participation or cancel reservations for nonpayment.
- K. Credit card chargebacks do not void these terms. If a chargeback is resolved in favor of Scopia LLC, a \$100 administrative fee will apply. Credit card refunds do not include the 3% processing fee.
