1. Touring Difficulty – Is This Tour Right for You?

The tour is not sold or offered as ADA-compliant. Aside from the beautiful sites and lots of fun on the tour, there is important information you should consider:

- Although porterage service will be provided, you may need to carry your luggage on occasion.
- Some of the days will entail bus rides of 2-4 hours (planned bathroom breaks).
- You will be boarding and getting off the bus 4-6 times per day, during touring days.
- Some of the days will entail several hours of walking on even and uneven pavements or roads, ascending and descending stairs (without railings), walking up or down hills, or standing in place for 20-30 minutes at a time, while listening to the guide's explanations.
- Some of the sites are not designed to accommodate travelers with walking difficulties or those who use walking accessories.
- The buses on the tour are not ADA-compliant and may not have bathrooms.
- It is possible to skip sites and stay in the hotel, with no refund for unused entrance fees.
- Temperatures will likely be in the 70's-80's during the daytime, depending on location. Evenings will likely be in the 60's. It may be colder in mountains areas (Jerusalem).
- Food allergies will be forwarded but may not be properly addressed by hotels and restaurants. Participants should be diligent about food consumed and bring an epi-pen if needed.



2. To Register for the Tour:

Registration for the tour is now open via the dedicated, secure form available on the tour website. The upfront pay now costs are:

• \$200 non-refundable deposit per person. It can be paid by check or credit card. This deposit will be refunded if a minimum of 30 participants is not reached by December 14, 2025.

Please have the following information/documents available prior to registration:

- Your passport (must be valid for at least 6 months beyond the date of return).
 - If you do not have a passport or if your passport expires prior to November 30, 2026, please apply for a new passport.
- Your TTP or Global Entry number (optional)
- Your El Al or Delta frequent flyer number (Optional)

Israel ETA: To participate in this tour, you must obtain an Electronic Travel Authorization to enter Israel (cost is about \$8). Please do not complete this task before being instructed to do so.

Seller of Travel: Scopia LLC is not registered as a "Seller of Travel" in the states of California, Hawaii and Washington. This tour is therefore offered to residents of these states **only** if their tour cost is entirely paid for as a gift by a resident of another state (for example: the uncle from Pennsylvania pays for his nephew in California to join the tour as a gift).

4. Included in the Tour Cost:

• Flights:

o Round trip economy class flights from Newark to Tel Aviv on El Al Israel Airlines. Includes airline taxes and fuel/security charges (taxes are subject to change prior to ticketing).

• Hotels (all in standard rooms unless otherwise mentioned)

- o Apr 22 Apr 23: 1 Night Tal by the Beach Hotel Tel Aviv
- o Apr 23 Apr 26: 3 Nights Kibbutz Ein Gev Hotel Sea of Galilee (Sea View)
- o Apr 26 May 01: 5 Nights Prima Royale Hotel Jerusalem (small rooms)

Meals:

- 8 Buffet breakfasts daily at the hotels.
- 9 Buffet dinners at hotels.
- o 1 Fish lunch by the Sea of Galilee (Apr 24).
- 1 Lunch by the Dead Sea (Apr 28)

• Bus, Touring and Transportation:

- o Arrival and departure airport transfers with local airport assistance and guide.
- o 8 Days of touring with a licensed professional tour guide (Yuval Kalev).
- o 10 Days of bus services including airport transfers with Wi-Fi on the bus.
- All entrance fees to sites visited and activity fees according to the itinerary.
- All staff expenses for accommodation, meals and mileage.
- All hotel service charges and taxes.
- Headsets for touring (\$100 fee for losing or damaging the device).
- For each participant: Name tag, electric adapter and 2 luggage tags.
- Escorted by Scopia LLC
- 24/7 Services of the local tour operators to ensure smooth operations and handle any problems.

5. Not Included in the Tour Cost:

- Any service not mentioned above as included in the tour costs, is not included. This refers (but is not limited) to meals not mentioned, drinks during meals, touring outside of the itinerary, passport fees, visas or ETA if needed, expenses of a personal nature such as airline upgrades, gifts, mini-bar purchases, or phone/data expenses.
- Also not included specifically for your group:
 - Domestic transportation in the US.
 - Israel <u>Electronic Travel Authorization</u> (ETA). Approximately \$8 per person.
 - o <u>Travel Insurance</u> to be purchased independently.
 - Any expenses related to COVID (testing, quarantine, hospitalization, travel disruptions).
 - Water on the bus: \$1 per ½ liter bottle sold individually.
 - Tips of \$200 per person (bring in cash to Israel).


7. Travel Insurance:

Scopia LLC serves only as an agent of the insurance company for the purpose of offering participants the option of purchasing insurance. Any decisions about claims are at the sole discretion of the insurance company. Scopia LLC can provide participants with available documentation to support a claim.

Disclosure: Offered travel insurance plans provide insurance coverage that only applies during the covered trip. You may have coverage from other sources that provides you with similar benefits but may be subject to different restrictions depending upon your other coverages. 8. Payment Schedule, Terms and Conditions:

- A. By paying, you signify that you represent the travel party and have read, understood, and agree to all sections of this brochure and Disclaimer below.
- B. Payments are accepted by check or wire transfer only, except for the initial deposits which can be paid by credit card, with an added 3% agency handling fee.
- C. Check payments should be sent to arrive by the due date to Scopia LLC, 8916 N Iroquois Road, Bayside, WI 53217. Please add "CLA 2026) to the memo line.

D. Important dates to remember:

- a. By December 14, 2025 or upon confirmation: A non-refundable deposit of \$200 per person.
- b. **December 15, 2025:** A deposit of \$1,000 per person is due and is non-refundable.
- c. **February 15, 2026:** Final payment is due and is non-refundable.

E. Refund periods and amounts (if you cancel):

- a. Cancel the tour by December 14, 2025: Penalty of \$200 per person deposit.
- b. Cancel between December 15, 2025 and February 14, 2026: Penalty of \$1,200 per person.
- c. Cancellations any time after February 14, 2026: All payments are non-refundable.

F. Cancellation of the tour by Scopia LLC:

- a. In the event the tour needs to be cancelled by December 14, 2025 due to insufficient registrations, initial deposits of \$200 per person will be refunded.
- b. Should the tour need to be cancelled due to reasons or events beyond the control of Scopia LLC (force majeure): Scopia LLC will work with tour suppliers for possible reimbursement of payments made. Airline tickets are non-refundable once purchased. Amounts received from suppliers will be reimbursed to tour participants, minus a fee of \$300 per person withheld for time and expenses by Scopia LLC.
- G. Important note: Payment and refund schedule and/or amounts are subject to change.
- H. There is no refund for unused services while traveling.
- I. Scopia LLC has the right to refuse participation to any registrant, for any reason and without the need to disclose such reasoning.
