How We Do It?

Businesses and organizations that choose to walk alongside young people who are exploring career options will need to follow these 5 simple steps...

ONE

Call and schedule an appointment with our Internship Director

TWO

Complete required documents online and submit Child Abuse Clearances every 5 years

THREE

Share what a student will learn at your business with the school

FOUR

Meet with a teacher to do a student check in on one scheduled Friday during the semester.

FIVE

Complete a final Performance Evaluation for your intern

What we do...

Linville Hill partners with regional businesses and organizations in cooperation with parents, and student advisors to offer practical instruction and career exploration for every student in grades 9-12. Each semester students will be offered a different internship experience for a total of 7 unique experiences.
