NRG Teams & Coaching for 2027

This season we have added some exciting new coaches and leaders. La Afungia, former Texas Image director and top 14s coach, will now be the NRG Player/Coach Development Coordinator and top 14s head coach. She will be joined by Ben Barber as the top 14s assistant. Taani Langi will be joining NRG as a 12s coach and a key component to developing our youth programming. JayJay Itaaehau and Jeremie Middleton will also be joining NRG bringing with them valuable club and college coaching experience. We currently have the best coaching staff in the SW area of North Texas, and with these additions we will solidify NRG as “Best club in the SW” for years to come. Along with these new additions we are implementing a new coaches training program for all our coaches so that we ensure every coach is onboard with our administration’s baseline training requirements and family culture we wish to instill in our teams, families, and coaches. TCU head coach, Jason Williams, will hold a coaches training sessions this summer in addition to our in-house training sessions.

We will be expanding our AMPD division to include 2 AMPD Navy teams for Ages 13U-17U. We are not trying to create 2 top teams, rather we are creating a competitive environment with the hope of qualifying 2 teams at each age group for Nationals each year. These teams will practice on the same nights so that they can scrimmage one another to create the most competitive teams, as possible, at the top of the NRG program. The 16-17U AMPD Navy teams will have an on-site recruiting director at 2 of their qualifiers to help bring college coaches and NRG families together to help in the recruiting process. This will also be an option for other teams as well (details coming soon).

On the National and Bolt level teams we are assigning some more experienced coaching and providing a more extensive coach’s training program to help our coaches enable those athletes, newer to the sport, to excel at a faster pace in reaching their volleyball potential. All teams will have a weekly positional session to further develop position specific mechanics.

AMPD Navy teams ages 15U-17U will have Nationals included in their fees. Teams will either qualify USAV or enter the AAU National championship. The idea behind this is to allow one more recruiting event for NRG players. Both events have very large numbers of college coaches attending and we have had several

players approached and even offered during this time. Our cost for Nationals is very reasonable compared to other organizations within our region. The costs cover the tourney, a warmup tourney, coaches salary for practices, and coaches travel. We do not charge any other fees (nationals is not a revenue stream, it is a recruiting opportunity to showcase our athletes). All teams will have the option to attend AAU National Championship and will be provided detailed information after tryouts have been completed.

NRG tryout process:

- Beginning May 4th we will start our pre-tryout evaluation clinics. There will be multiple sessions per week until the end of June. The schedule can be found on our web page. Players do not have to attend all sessions. We have multiple sessions per week to allow players to get a good look from our coaching staff. There is not a set number of clinics athletes need to attend. It is summer break for our athletes, and we want them to enjoy their summer. However, they need to attend enough clinics to allow coaches to give them a good assessment.
- May 18 we will begin to extend verbal team offers to all players that are attending the clinics. Some current NRG players will receive verbal offers before the 18th. Verbal offers will continue to be made until the last week of June.
- July 7 NRG will have our signing day where parents and players will come in to be fitted for their uniform and take part in our signing day celebration.
- Each tryout session is \$40 for individual session. We do have multi-session passes to accommodate the first 2 week of clinics until the verbal offer date. \$120 for 4-day pass and \$200 for 8-day pass. After the verbal offer date (May 18), all sessions will be individual.

Tryout concerns:

- Parents and athletes should not be concerned if they do not immediately receive a team offer. Most players will be playing for new coaches, and those coaches need time to evaluate each athlete so that we can make the best teams possible. Some players will get offers earlier than others but that typically comes from coaches that are familiar with the athletes' abilities.
- When your athlete does receive an offer from NRG or any other club, please do not accept an offer until your athlete is sure where they want to play. We understand that you want to find the best fit for your child, but please remember there are other athletes looking for a position at their favorite club and that by accepting an offer you are removing a spot for other athletes on that specific team. We ask for 1 of 3 responses when giving a verbal offer:
 - o Accept – means the athlete is agreeing to play for that specific team
 - o Decline – means the athlete does not want or like the offer presented to them
 - Decline does not mean that we will not evaluate the athlete for other teams. If an athlete declines the offer, they will continue to be evaluated for another team.
 - o Undecided – means the athlete wants to think about the offer and weigh all options that they have.
 - If we receive an undecided response that does not mean, we will immediately remove the offer. We will give a grace period in which the athlete can decide to accept or decline. If we have not received an answer within the grace period, the offer will be made available to others
- Athletes that will be out of town during the tryout process. If this is the case with your athlete, let us know in advance and we will setup an evaluation session for them.
- NRG verbal offers are non-binding per the NTR regulations. However, once we give an offer, we do not rescind that offer unless the athlete drops out of communication with the club and/or coach. Please keep that in mind when going to multiple club evaluations so that your athlete does not put a club and team in a bad position on signing day. We hope all players find the best club to fit their needs and we hope that is NRG, but if it is not, we understand and will be respectful of your decision.

NRG Uniforms:

- This season players/parents will order and pay for their uniforms from the online store. They will not be included in the club fees. For those players returning to NRG this can be a cost savings because your athlete already has the basic uniforms. Jerseys and warmups are will change but spandex, socks, kneepads, & backpacks will remain the same. The sizing will start to take place as soon as an athlete accepts their verbal offer. We will continue to have fittings until signing day so that we ensure our order gets put in early so that our athletes get uniforms earlier, so that any corrections can be made before first tourneys.

Fun Stuff:

- **NRG Family Cookout** – This will take place in October. This will be the 7th annual cookout, and it is a great way for families to get together and have a good time before the club season begins 😊 We will have food, games, and football watching for all. Details will be provided via the coaching staff as soon as signing day has been completed.
- **NRG Christmas Party** – This will also be the 7th annual session of this event. This is a potluck event where teams and families get together for gift exchanges and a little social mingling to kick-off the holiday season.
- **Smash Sports:** NRG family discount. If you have a player on an NRG club team you will receive a 20% discount off the VIP package for golf, pickleball, or total club membership @ Smash Sports that sits just across from the NRG building. For those parents that love to play pickleball or golf, this can be a good opportunity to pass the time during those 2-hr practices 😊
