Q: How do vanpool programs benefit my business?

A: A vanpool program can benefit your employees, your business, and the environment!

Q: Who pays for employees to use the service?

Q: How do you determine where routes are needed?

A: We provide an analysis of common commuter areas and locate transit gaps that a vanpool can help fill.

Q: What if some employees don't work on-site every day?

A: We offer a flexible solution for participants with any schedule. Participants can choose how many days they want to ride with the flexibility to change month-to-month.

Q: How can I ensure my company & employees are protected?

A: Driver and rider safety is always a top priority. Vanpool vehicles include vehicle liability coverage, physical damage protection, 24/7 roadside assistance & vehicle maintenance.

Q: What happens if a rider needs to leave work before their vanpool does?

A: We work with employers to build and implement a guaranteed ride home program.

Q: Who drives the vanpool?

A: Driving responsibility is shared among authorized drivers in the vanpool. To be eligible, a driver must submit an application meet our qualifications before they are eligible to drive in a vanpool.
