Evaluation & Team Placement Process

Our evaluation process is designed to fully assess each athlete's skill set while maintaining a calm, supportive environment.

Team Placement Steps

1. **Register Online** - Opens March 15th
2. **Complete the Athlete Information Packet** - this will be sent out after your athlete is registered for tryouts
3. **Learning the Materials 6/5**
4. **Individual Evaluation 6/6**
5. **Team Callbacks 6/7**
6. **Team Placements Released 6/7**

Team placements are professional decisions made with athlete development in mind. Placements may change throughout the season based on skill progression, attendance, injuries, or role needs.

Team Placement Schedule & Fees

All athletes are required to attend all three days of our team placement process. If your athlete will miss any part of the team placement process please reach out to Coach Hannah to see if a private evaluation is necessary. If your athlete is unavailable for the whole weekend of 6/5-6/7 they will be required to attend a private tryout. This can be set up by emailing Hannah at Unchalkedcheer@gmail.com. As a reminder, team placement registration opens on March 15th, 2026. Placement fees include learning the material, an athlete's individual evaluation, and team callbacks.

Team Placement Fees

- Early Registration (March 15– May 3): **\$40**
- On-Time Registration (May 4 – June 4): **\$50**
- Day-Of Registration: **\$60**
- Private Tryout: **\$80**

If you are a new member to Unchalked Cheer or it has been a year since you created an account your account will also be charged an additional \$40 registration fee.

6/7 12:00-2:00pm or 2:30-4:30pm	Team Callbacks	Athletes will be given a time slot to come back and practice with a team. During this time athletes will be placed into stunt groups and do group tumbling.

6/10	Pink Party	This is a welcome party for all athletes on full season teams for the 2026-2027 season! Athletes

		will have photo opportunities, parents will be able to ask general questions, and we will celebrate the start of the season!!
6/10	Practices Begin	Each team will have their first practice of the season during this date range. Exact dates will be pending your athlete's team practice schedule. Team practice schedule will be posted with team placement.

Season Schedule & Fees

Unchalked Cheer utilizes an **all-inclusive monthly tuition model** to help families plan financially.

Full Year All Star Tuition:

\$210/month June - July

\$275/month August - April

Included:

- During the summer 1 Practice per week: Wednesday or Thursday
- Starting in August 2 Practices per week: Wednesdays/Thursday & Sundays
- 1 Tumbling class per week - athletes choice (3 days)
- Coaches' fees
- All stunt and routine choreography

Not Included:

- Mandatory Summer Cheer Camp August 3-7 (\$275)
- Custom Music Fee - \$50 taken out on July 1st
- Uniforms, shoes, warm ups, backpacks, bows, & hair pieces
- Competition Fees (billed separately in 6 installments of \$120 or a 1 time charge of \$720) this does not include Nationals comp fee
- Post-season events
- Travel expenses

Important Summer Dates

June 10: First Practice

August 3-7: **MANDATORY** Cheer Camp

August 15-16: **MANDATORY** Routine Choreography

Payment Policy

Payments are due by the 1st of each month. If payment is not received by the 7th of each month your account will be charged a \$10 late fee and your athlete will sit out of practice until your account is reconciled. All payments go through iclasspro, and you must have an active credit card on file at all times. Please note that there are no refunds for injuries. There will be no refunds for anyone who is asked to leave the program or who quits the team. A termination fee

of \$300 may be charged for violation of terms.

Competition Schedule & Fees

The national travel full year team will be attending at least 6 competitions with the main goal of achieving a bid to Nationals. Attendance at Nationals is **mandatory**. The non travel full year team will be attending 6 competitions. There is a possibility of additional competitions being added. Competitions may be rescheduled at vendors discretion.

There are two payment options for competition fees. A one time payment of \$720 or a payment plan of 6 \$120 installments charged October 1st, November 1st, December 1st, January 1st, February 1st and March 1st.

Team schedules for each competition will be released approximately 1 week before the competition date. Please reserve the weekends below to allow flexibility for scheduling. Competitions typically don't require an overnight stay but this is always optional and we will send out hotel information as competitions get closer. Please plan for 5-7 hours on competition day at the host venue.

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Uniform Packages

The following items are required for all full year team members, the others are optional. We will have a uniform sizing and ordering day during one of our scheduled practices in June. Uniform and warm up styling is guaranteed for 3 years. Sizing adjustments may be necessary with athlete growth.

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Attendance Policy

All absences must be submitted via email or team snap for approval by Coach Hannah. If an absence is not submitted or not approved it will be counted as unexcused. ***If your athlete receives more than 3 unexcused absences they will be removed from the team and you are responsible for paying the rest of the season.***

Summer

June 10 - August 31: During the summer we expect athletes to be at practice unless they are out of town.

Competition Season

September 1 - March 31: Practices are *MANDATORY* unless previously approved by Coach Hannah. All practices the week of a competition are *MANDATORY*. If your athlete misses a practice the week of a competition they ***WILL NOT*** be permitted to compete.

Post Season for the National Travel Team

All of April: All practices are *MANDATORY* in the month of April to compete at All Star Worlds. If your athlete misses a practice they will be removed from the team.

Excused Practices: Contagious Illness, Death/Grievance and School Event for a Grade

Unexcused Practices: Birthday Parties, Family Dinners, Other Sports, Cough/Stomach Ache/Headache, etc.

Vacations: We ask that you ***DO NOT*** schedule any vacations during the competition season which is September-April. The only vacations that will be approved are during Summer, Winter Break and Spring Break.

Code of Conduct

Here at Unchalked Cheer we strive to have an environment that allows for each athlete to feel comfortable and accepted by all. We want each athlete, parent or spectator to treat everyone with respect while inside Unchalked Cheer. Please note the following behaviors will not be accepted during practice, any team time or at competitions.

1. Name calling or negative talk of others
2. Physical contact such as hitting, pinching, biting, kicking, etc.
3. Making inappropriate gestures at a parent, athlete or staff member
4. Harassment or making threats

If any of the following occur, the athlete will receive the following consequences

1. Meeting with the athlete and coaches to discuss what happened. A phone call will be made to the parents to let them know what had happened
2. Meeting with the athlete, parents and coaches
3. Dismissed from the team
