SERVICE CHARGE(S) EXPLANATION

Consultation / Coordinating activities, rites, ceremonies **

Professional consultation with licensed personnel and making necessary arrangements on behalf of the family, such as: clergy, cemetery/crematorium, newspapers, ordering chosen family flowers, additional vehicles if needed, reception, reserved seating. This also covers telephone services available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. **NO CREDIT**

Documentation **

Completion of all required documents to carry out the services and supplies requested including but not limited to, burial/cremation permit, coroner's cremation certificate, CPP/Survivor's Benefit applications, OAS cancellation, Cemetery Consent Form. Preparing and issuing any correspondence, contract/invoice, maintenance of necessary records for future use and most importantly, funeral director's proof of death certificates. These proof of death certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial "Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General. **NO CREDIT**

Initial transportation (additional fees apply beyond 50 km)**

Transportation of the remains to the funeral home in an unmarked vehicle. A charge applies for each transportation request or requirement. **NO CREDIT**

NOTE: If more than one attendant is required for **ANY** reason in order to make a dignified transfer(s), there is a surcharge of \$75.00 per attendant required.

Basic Preparation of remains **

The preparation of the body for placement into the casket, including bathing, dressing and the setting of facial features for identification or private family viewing (max 30 minute period) only without embalming. Any additional private family viewing will be **\$100.00/hr.** or part thereof per viewing. **NO CREDIT**

Embalming of remains (also requires basic preparation of remains)

This charge is in addition to Basic Preparation of remains** This is a procedure in which the bodily fluids are replaced by a chemical preservative. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Cosmetics, hairdressing, dressing and casketing of deceased. Embalming is not a legal requirement in Ontario. However, the Mangan Funeral Home requires embalming or other special treatment of remains in certain circumstances. If the final disposition is delayed for any reason in excess of 96hrs following death, embalming will be required. If embalming is not acceptable, then refrigeration will be required. There is a fee per day or part thereof for refrigeration plus a transfer charge each way to the refrigeration facilities. (charges will be quoted by the funeral director)

Staff - Services for Visitation

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation/informal gathering for the desired period of time. Accepting and recording memorial donations or Mass requests, setting up flowers, greeting the public.

Staff – Services for Ceremony

Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony or memorial service for a period of up to two hours.

Facilities/Equipment for visitation

(Requires Staff Services for Visitation)

Designated facility used for visitation for the desired period of time on-site, or off-site. Use of funeral home chapel for visitation. This price reflects the cost for the maintenance of the building, heat, hydro, telephone, rental fee/donation & custodial fees . When off-site, rental fee/donation & custodial fees for local facilities (**within 40km of Beaverton**) where visitation is held and the supply and use of necessary, funeral home owned equipment. This does not include costs incurred for the use, supply or operation of any non-owned funeral home equipment.

Facilities/Equipment for Ceremony

(Requires Staff Services for Ceremony)

Designated facility used for ceremony or memorial service. Use of funeral home chapel for visitation/services. These prices cover insurance for premises, property taxes, licensing fees to legally operate, maintenance of building, heat, hydro, telephone and other utilities. When off-site, rental fee/donation & custodial fees for local facility where ceremony or memorial service is held and the supply and use of any necessary, funeral home equipment (**within 40km of Beaverton**) . This does not include costs incurred for the use, supply or operation of any non-owned funeral home equipment.

Facilities for Preparation/embalming/shelter **

Use of facilities for embalming or alternate care as requested by the family. If the final disposition is delayed for any reason in excess of 96 hrs following death, an additional charge of \$50.00 per day or any part thereof will be incurred. **NO CREDIT**

Service Vehicle (additional fees apply after 50 km)

Used for the transfer of deceased to cemetery/crematorium, if the funeral coach is not required/requested. If this vehicle is used in place of a funeral coach for more than 2 hours on a service, an additional \$30.00 /hr surcharge will apply.

Administration Vehicle (additional fees apply after 50 km)**

Not limited to but includes driving clergy to cemetery/crematorium, leading a funeral procession, for delivery and pick up of necessary documentation i.e.: coroner's certificate, death registration permit. It is also used to move or deliver flowers, pictures etc. to place of service or other location if needed or requested by family. **NO CREDIT**

Funeral Coach (additional fees apply after 50 km)

Attendance at site of funeral service for the transfer of the deceased to cemetery/crematorium, winter storage vault etc. If this vehicle is required for more than a maximum of 2 hours per funeral, an additional \$50.00/hr surcharge will apply.
