I recommend UCB's podcast "**The Bible Storyline Simplified**" I've just finished listening to.

There are 17 episodes each about 30 minutes long. So, it is great to listen to when doing the housework etc. Basically, Bible Scholar and author Phil Moore explains the background to each book of the bible from Genesis to Revelation and how they connect.

It is pitched at a simple level for those who haven't read the Bible before. Yet still good for those who are fairly familiar with the Bible. As Phil Moore says there are many levels to reading and understanding the Bible which open up as you delve deeper into it.

He also gives some great tips on how to read the Bible and where to start if you never read the Bible before.
