### SYRINGE DRIVER COMPETENCY PROGRAMME

**Venue:** McDougall House

The Hospice New Zealand Syringe Driver Competency Programme is for registered and enrolled nurses and develops the knowledge and skills required to manage subcutaneous infusions using the Niki T34 / Bodyguard T syringe driver.

Initial certification involves completion of pre-reading, attendance at a two-hour workshop, demonstration of practical competence and completion of a written test. Alternately the theory and clinical calculations can be completed online. Certification is maintained by attending a 2 yearly update.

### SYRINGE DRIVER AWARENESS FOR HCAs

### FOUNDATIONS IN PALLIATIVE CARE

- Spiritual Care

### PALLIATIVE CARE FOR CAREGIVERS

This Hospice New Zealand education programme is an alternative to Fundamentals of Palliative Care and helps caregivers, working in all care settings, explore their role in providing palliative care.

The course consists of four 90-minute seminars and is usually delivered on site to a group of caregivers. There is a small cost for the course workbook.
