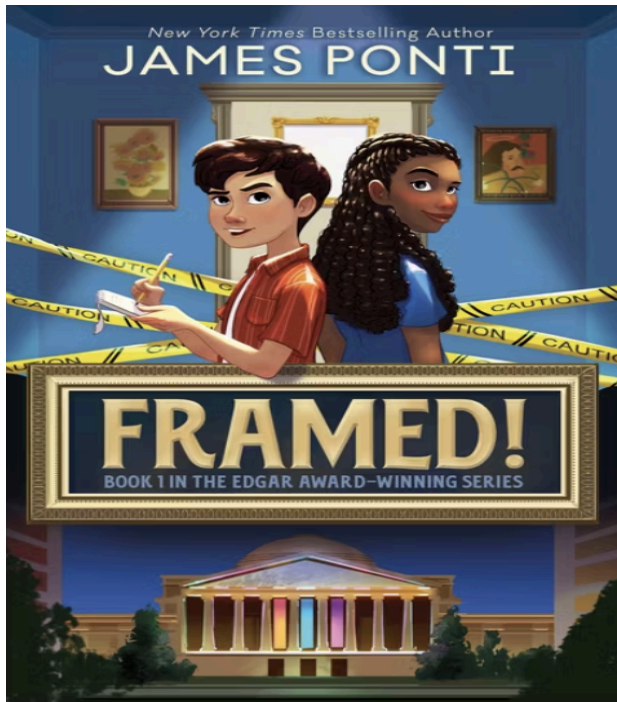


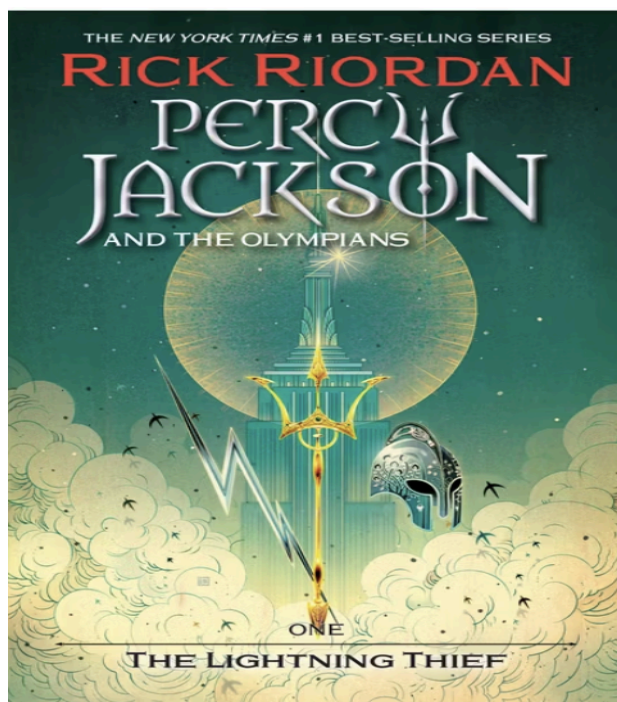
Sixth Grade Summer Reading

Framed! is the first book in this middle school mystery series written by James Ponti. Florian and his best friend, Margaret, use TOAST-The Theory of All Small Things - to help the FBI find stolen pieces of art taken from the National Gallery of Art in Washington, D.C. The smallest pieces of evidence pieced together reveals the solution to this mystery.



Percy Jackson and the Olympians: The Lightning Thief by Rich Riordan is about a young boy who discovers that he is the son of the Greek god, Poseidon. Percy wants to learn the truth about his identity and where he fits into the world. Percy struggles with the desire to prove himself. His mother's disappearance prompts Percy to accept his quest to find Zeus's Master Bolt and return it to Olympus.
