Requirements to Volunteer (Regular or 4+ hours/month)

Attend Virtus Training Session

- Selection.com Background Check via Virtus portal
 - One-time \$25 fee, updates quarterly

Read and sign (4) required policies:

- Employee & Volunteer Code of Conduct
- Policy for the Safety of Children
- Standards of Conduct for Ministry
- Volunteer Acknowledgement Form



Sign-up

Sign-up Genius

- Links by period/grade will be sent out for the entire year.
- Sign-up regularly (days, weeks, etc.) or specific days that fit your schedule
- Art and Library sign-ups per homeroom will also be available (Sent out separately by Mrs. Whitehead and Ms. Wiersma)
- Please make arrangements for other siblings when coming in to volunteer.
- Outside food (fast food, etc.) should not be brought in for your child or other children.
- Make changes in the Sign-up Genius

Checking-in/Checking-out

- Sign-in at the Welcome Center/Main Office to receive a badge
- Badge must be worn in a conspicuous place.
- Check-in with the Aide or teacher on duty to find out your area/zone for the playground, cafeteria, and classroom (if indoor recess).
- Phones should be put away (no photographs of/with other children-part of Virtus)
- Sign-out and return your badge at conclusion your time.



Duties

- #1 Duty is to assist with student supervision and safety
 - Cafeteria, playground, classrooms
- Cafeteria:
 - Assist with opening, volume, table/floor clean-up
 - All lunch boxes should be collected in the baskets and table/floor clean before dismissal
 - Walk to/from recess and stay on the sidewalk
 - Insist on manners
 - No food or drink outside



Duties

- Playground/Blacktop/Gaga Pit
 - Circulate your area/zone (head on a swivel)
 - No students behind the garage or dumpsters
 - Intervene/correct to ensure safe, fair, and inclusive play
 - Keep students within the coned area
 - Only adults may retrieve balls that roll under cars or into the driveway
 - Not a discussion about "why" the student did what they did... We "don't do that at this school"
 - Directives to help clean-up equipment at the bell get into line
 - Report incidents to aide or teacher on duty
 - Grades 7 & 8 are not permitted on the climbing structure/slides
 - Aide posted by the door will swipe students into the building (bathroom/nurse)



Duties

- Indoor Recess (classrooms)
 - Rules posted in each classroom for acceptable activities
 - No switching rooms
 - One person to the restroom at a time
 - Be mindful of time for clean-up so students are ready to learn upon teacher return



How to Intervene

- Rock, Paper, Scissors
- Call a Do Over
- Sit out 5 minutes (bench or on the line) to reset/calm down
 - "We don't do that"
 - What can you do next time?
- Report to the Aide/teacher on duty
 - Parents do not issue demerits or detentions
- Confidentiality is imperative.
