#### Brother Knights and families,

As we enter a joyful, busy season, may your Homes be filled with Faith, Joy, and Peace. November is remembrance: we lovingly commend our deceased loved ones to God's mercy. We especially recall our Brother Knights and their spouses; we will offer a Mass for them. Let us reach out to their families with prayer, notes, and tangible care. On Nov 23 we acclaim Christ the King, surrendering every corner of life to His rule. On Nov 30 we begin Advent, a fresh start in grace and a school of holy longing. Make your Advent intentional: schedule Confession and come to the Lord's embrace. Reconcile with one another; forgive quickly; ask forgiveness humbly. Pray the Rosary daily place your family and our parish in Mary's hands. Open the Bible each day; let the Gospel correct, console, and commission you. Use the Little Advent Purple **Book** to keep your heart anchored in hope. **Practice quiet:** five minutes of silence before the manger changes everything. Choose kindness on purpose: join our Christmas Giving and serve the hidden poor. Remember Pope Leo's recent encyclical: love the poor, refugees, the marginalized, the immigrant. Don't get caught in political rhetoric; do not lose your soul to anger or fear. Let your charity be bold, your speech clean, your heart wide.

Knights, lead by example—be first to pray, first to help, first to reconcile.

Support parish life generously; show up, step up, and lift others up. Husbands and fathers: bless your families nightly and bring them to Sunday Mass. Young Knights: let your strength serve Christ, not the ego. Seniors: mentor with tenderness; your wisdom steadies the ship.

**Keep Christ in Christmas**—worship, rest, give, and keep holy the day. As the **New Year** dawns, renew our four pillars: Charity, Unity, Fraternity, Patriotism. Resolve to be men of the **Eucharist and Apostles of Mercy in 2026.** I am praying for you; walk in courage, keep watch in hope, rejoice in the Lord.


