



Colorado Rush Announces Blair Quinn as Director of Goalkeeping

Colorado Rush Soccer Club is proud to announce the hiring of Blair Quinn as the club's new Director of Goalkeeping. Quinn brings more than 25 years of experience developing goalkeepers at the youth, collegiate, professional, and international levels.



In his role as Director of Goalkeeping, Quinn will lead the development and implementation of the club's goalkeeper curriculum across all age groups. He will work closely with Colorado Rush coaches to ensure a consistent training methodology while providing specialized goalkeeper training and mentorship throughout the club's pathway.

Quinn currently serves as Assistant Coach and Goalkeeper Coach at Texas Tech University, where he has been part of one of the most successful periods in program history. During the 2023 season, Texas Tech completed the first undefeated regular season in program history with a 14-0-4 record and captured its first Big 12 regular season championship. Under Quinn's guidance, goalkeeper Madison White was named Big 12 Goalkeeper of the Year and First Team All-American, later signing professionally with Racing Louisville of the NWSL. Another Texas Tech goalkeeper, Faith Nguyen, earned First Team All-Big 12 honors and later signed with Angel City FC.

Prior to Texas Tech, Quinn served as Associate Head Coach and Goalkeeper Coach at the University of Iowa from 2019 to 2023, where he helped lead the program to historic milestones, including the 2020 Big Ten Tournament Championship, the first NCAA Tournament win in program history, and multiple NCAA Tournament appearances. His earlier collegiate experience also includes roles as Associate Head Coach at the University of Houston, Assistant Coach at Arizona State University, and Head Coach at New Mexico State University.

Quinn also brings professional experience from the Houston Dash of the National Women's Soccer League (NWSL), where he worked as an Assistant Coach and Goalkeeper Coach. During his time with the Dash, he coached internationally recognized goalkeepers including Jane Campbell (U.S. Women's National Team), Lydia Williams (Australia Women's National Team), and Bianca Henninger (Mexico Women's National Team).

In addition to his coaching background, Quinn holds some of the highest coaching certifications in the country, including the U.S. Soccer A License and the U.S. Soccer National Goalkeeper License, along with advanced diplomas from United Soccer Coaches.

Colorado Rush is excited to welcome Blair Quinn to the Rush family and looks forward to the continued growth of the club's goalkeeper program under his leadership.
