



Parent Code of Conduct

As a parent/guardian of a player in the Marshfield High School Girls Soccer Program, I understand that my role is to support my child, the team, and the coaching staff in creating a positive and healthy athletic environment. I have read and understand the expectations below:

Sideline Behavior & Sportsmanship

- I will model positive sportsmanship at all times.
- I will not yell at coaches, officials, players (on either team), or other spectators.
- I will avoid negative comments, coaching from the sidelines, or behavior that undermines the team environment.

Communication & Program Structure

- I understand that players, not parents, are responsible for communicating with coaches about attendance, concerns, or questions.
- I will follow the chain of communication if an issue arises: Player → Captains → Coach → Athletic Department
- I will respect coaching decisions regarding playing time, positions, and strategy.

Support for My Athlete

- I will encourage my child to take responsibility for their own communication, equipment, and preparation.
- I will help ensure they arrive on time, ready to participate, and committed to the team.
- I will support expectations around conditioning, recovery, nutrition, and academics.
- I will provide valid documentation when my child must be absent or dismissed.

Equipment & Program Responsibilities

- I will help ensure uniforms, bags, pinnies, and equipment are returned clean and in good condition at the end of the season.
- I will respect all team rules, school policies, and MIAA regulations.

Program Culture

- I will contribute to a positive, inclusive environment that prioritizes growth, teamwork, and enjoyment of the sport.
- I will trust the coaching staff to make decisions in the best interest of the team and the program.
