Middle School Student Focus

This week, your son or daughter heard a teaching about how God created each of us with a conscience and that it is our responsibility to form it. This was followed by an opportunity to brainstorm ideas on how to do this and discussion within their small groups.

- The Ten Commandments are God's instructions on how to lead holy lives and our formed consciences are the inner voice that helps us do good and avoid evil.

- Jesus assists us in the formation of our conscience by giving us a standard to measure our actions. He provides rules because He loves us and wants us to live a blessed and happy life.
- Continually forming our conscience helps us to judge right from wrong more easily. With the help of the Holy Spirit and frequent reading of the Bible, we become familiar with God's plan for us and the manner in which we should live.

Scripture:

Matthew 7:12 Romans 2:14-16 Philippians 4:8

High School Student Focus

Each week, students read scripture and engage in group discussion.

Topics:

- Jesus is unique
- Jesus does what God does
- What does it mean for us if we call Jesus Lord?

Scripture:

- Matthew 16:13-17
- John 14:6, 10:30, 8:58
- Psalm 107:28-30
- Matthew 8:23-27, 9:2-7

Student Challenge

Middle School: Ask a trusted adult for advice about a difficult situation and continue these conversations as one way to form your conscience. *Parents, talk to your students about who a trusted adult should be.

High School: Start each day with a conversation with God. Say, "hello", "thank you for this day," add a prayer.

Family Reflection Questions

Ask your student:

- Why did God give us the Ten Commandments?
- How can your conscience help you?
- Let's think about what we watch and listen to, how we talk, and who we spend time with.
- Does our family need to eliminate any bad examples? What good examples influence our family?
