



Please follow the Traffic Flow directions below for student drop-off and pickup to ensure everyone's safety. Please share this information with anyone bringing or picking up your child and student drivers.

- 1. Enter from Village Road.
- 2. Turn left into the second parking lot.
- 3. Use the drop-off location under the covered driveway.
- 4. Return to the lower parking area and head towards Village Road.
- 5. Please only exit through Village Road.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

6th - 11th Grade

When you arrive, please make sure that 6th to 11th-grade students go directly to the Parish Center Assembly Area. For your child's safety, please don't drop them off earlier than 15 minutes before their classes start.

When dropping off your children, please use the covered drop-off area or park in the front parking lot, where a volunteer will assist with their safe arrival. It's important not to drop off, park, or pick up in the back parking lot behind the church or the shell parking lot next to the parish center, as there is no adult supervision in these areas.

For everyone's safety, please remember that the Parish Center doors will be locked 5 minutes after the start of class. If you drop off your child later than 5 minutes after the start of class, please accompany them to the Parish Center and check in with the front office. If you need help, please call the Parish office at 647-3696.

When classes are dismissed, students can go to the parking lot to meet their parents or guardians. Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe!

1st-5th Grade

To ensure a smooth transition, parents should accompany their child to the Assembly Area in the Parish Center during the initial two weeks of class. Following this period, students can be dropped off under the covered drop-off area *not more than 15 minutes* before class, where a volunteer will assist them in safely reaching their destination. For safety reasons, students should not walk unaccompanied from a parked vehicle. The Safety Team will permit students to exit the car only 15 minutes before class begins. Please remember that supervision in the Parish Center will start 15 minutes before class starts.

For everyone's safety, please remember that the Parish Center doors will be locked 5 minutes after the start of class. If you drop off your child later than 5 minutes after the start of class, please accompany them to the Parish Center and check in with the front office. If you need help, please call the Parish office at 647-3696.

At dismissal, students must be collected from their classroom by a parent, guardian, or an authorized adult listed on the registration form. Please get in touch with us if you need to add someone to the pick-up list.
