Middle School Student Focus

With the main teaching of this week's session, your son or daughter heard that living in community is not easy and often requires asking for and giving forgiveness to others. Jesus and St. Paul teach us how to address conflicts in community and we can rest, knowing that our mistakes do not exclude us from community.

- Living in community is not always easy – we are imperfect people who can hurt one another by our words and actions – but the opportunity to forgive and be forgiven strengthens the community.

- Jesus taught us how to address conflicts with our brothers and sisters and how to seek and extend forgiveness. Saint Paul gives us practical tips for living in community life through his letters in the Bible.
- Our mistakes do not exclude us from the Church or our community; they are chances to grow in humility and trust.

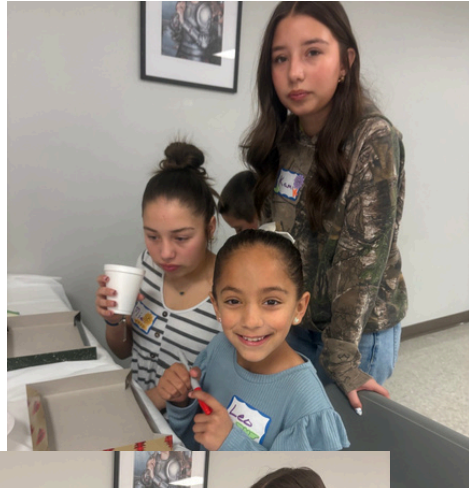
