What are cremated remains?

Cremated remains are grey in color
and granular in form.



The average adult is 8-10 cups of “ash.”



Cremated remains are typically selected by families choosing permanent placement.



What are solidified remains?

Solidified remains are stone-like and usually white in color.



The average adult is 25-35 “stones.”





Want to learn more about solidified remains?

Solidification takes 6 weeks to complete.



The color and texture are 100% natural.

Most of the time they appear
smooth and white.



Sometimes there are
beautiful radical variations.
