

55th Annual National Racking Horse Association World Championship Jamboree Horse Show 2025 Exhibitor Guidelines

1. Entry Booth will close at 6:30 P.M. You may still enter after the entry booth closes with a \$10 late fee added.
Checks - There will be a \$50.00 fee on any returned checks. Prize money will be attached to ribbons.
2. Refunds – A full refund will be issued in the event of illness or injury to horse or rider, no refunds will be given if entry is excused from the class.
3. Attire & Equipment – Proper Show Ring Attire & Show Ring Equipment is required in all classes, please check your rule book for the requirements of each class/division.
4. Championship Classes – Horse MUST qualify to show back in any Championship Classes.
5. Speed Racking Grand Championship – Horse must qualify in another designated SPEED class before they can show in the Speed Grand Championship. For safety please use caution when warming up your horses up.
6. Grand Championship Classes – In order to show in Grand Championship Classes, horse must have shown in a previously designated ***qualifying class. ONLY the classes marked with an *** are qualifying classes for the Grand Championship.

*The NRH will have volunteers at the Tn State Show in Cleveland on Aug 16th to collect money.

*The box seats will have a table and seating for six (6), if you choose to use your own chair please turn in the one provided by the show. NO other seating will be allowed in the box seat area.

*NO outside shavings are allowed per Tri-States. Please contact David Latham (865.556.9536) for your shavings order. Shavings are \$10 per bag and all stalls with a horse in it must have shavings.

*If you had stalls last year they will remain in your name as long as payment for them is postmarked by Aug 16th, if payment is not received then the stalls will be available to the next person on the stall list.

Such injuries may be caused by other participants, the undersigned, arena conditions including uneven or damaged terrain, the presence of moisture or mud, obstacles & obstructions upon or under the terrain & other natural or man-made conditions which may be hazardous to the undersigned or create hazards to the undersigned's activities. The undersigned further acknowledges that these equestrian activities are inherently dangerous & assumes all risks of injury and/or damages which may result from any reason whatsoever thereby. **Binding Effect.** The foregoing provisions shall be fully binding upon & shall be effective against the undersigned, its heirs, successors, legal representatives or assigns & shall apply to the actions of the undersigned personally, the undersigned's family, guests, employees or agents.
