OUR FAVORITE WHITE PAINT

The trickiest color in the deck

Of all the colors we work with, white is the hardest to choose. There are countless shades and undertones to consider, and every room's light changes the answer. After years of testing whites in real homes, we keep coming back to these five, arranged here from lightest to darkest.



OUR RULE: SAMPLE ON TWO WALLS AND WATCH IT FROM MORNING TO EVENING



NO. 01 • BENJAMIN MOORE OC-65

Chantilly Lace

The cleanest white of the group, bright and fresh with almost no undertone. A favorite for shiplap, ceilings, and coastal rooms that need to feel crisp against blues and naturals.

THE LIGHTEST OF OUR FIVE



NO. 02 • BENJAMIN MOORE OC-117

Simply White

Warm and luminous. It holds its brightness in rooms with less light, which makes it one of the hardest working whites in the book.





NO. 03 • BENJAMIN MOORE OC-17

White Dove

The classic, and for good reason. Soft and warm without drifting yellow, it flatters millwork and cabinetry and keeps its composure next to marble and natural wood.

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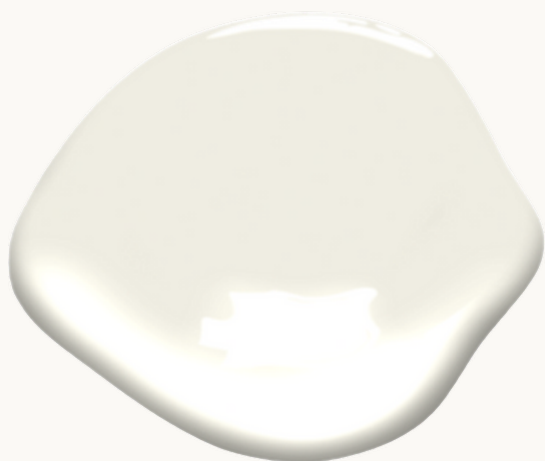
