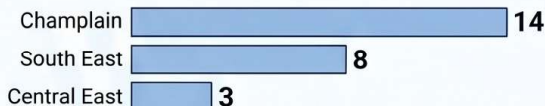


Essential community-based foot health support

Non-medical care including nail trimming, monitoring, and soaking provided by trained personnel.

25 Participating Agencies

Wide regional engagement with 14 agencies in Champlain, 8 in South East, and 3 in Central East.



Staff-Coordinated Clinic Model



Clinics are primarily staff-led



Utilizing contracted providers with specialized training

REGIONAL FINDINGS & ACCESS ELIGIBILITY

No Formal Assessment Required



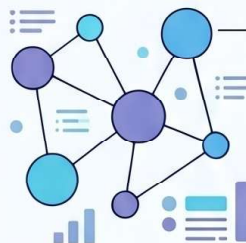
16 out of 25 agencies do not require formal standardized assessments for this service.



Targeted Eligibility

Serves older adults and adults with disabilities, ineligibility involves safety or scope concerns.
