ABSENT: Harris Cheramie Jr.


President Melancon opened the floor for any public comment, being none, he presented for the board's consideration to reject the bid for the Slip D Sweep Dredging project. Deputy Port Director stated we received one bid in the amount of \$5,553,194 from Orion Industrial Construction which was over budget. We made several attempts to negotiate the time and pricing.

The recommendation is to reject bids and readvertise at a later date. Upon motion by K. Callais second by C. Callais, with no public comment, the board unanimously approved to reject the bid for the Slip D Sweep Dredging project.
