

## **VISITING RULES IN HISTORICAL, CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS**

**SITES** ✓ Follow the rules posted in the areas you will visit and the warnings of the officials.

- ✓ Make your visit according to the religious and cultural sensitivities of the location you will visit.
- ✓ For example, mosque, tomb, etc. During your visits, choose clothing suitable for hijab, and do not enter areas with shoes that cannot be entered with shoes.
- ✓ Do not pollute the environment of historical areas and do not light fires.
- ✓ Do not write or draw pictures on historical buildings and artifacts.
- ✓ Do not touch historical artifacts or take any objects from historical sites.
- ✓ Do not take photos in places where photography is prohibited.
- ✓ Take photos without using flash to avoid damaging historical artifacts.
- ✓ During the trip, take into account the sensitivities of the society and avoid disturbing others. ✓  
Do not talk loudly in the areas and do not enter with food or drink.

## **RULES FOR VISITING NATURAL AREAS**

- ✓ Do not engage in any activities that pollute the areas, damage the flora or disturb the fauna. ✓  
Do not light fires in the areas and do not damage trees and plants.
- ✓ Do not participate in activities that harm animals and natural environments.
- ✓ Do not damage the landscape areas of pets.
- ✓ Do not engage in activities that may harm the birds (do not disturb individuals, do not touch their nests and chicks).
- ✓ Do not observe or take photographs during the breeding periods of birds.
- ✓ Do not act in a way that will frighten or disturb wild animals.
- ✓ Do not collect eggs of wild animals and do not disturb their nests.
- ✓ Do not follow or destroy wildlife.

## **TRAVEL RULES IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

- ✓ You can always assist the elderly, children, disabled and pregnant people according to their priority when boarding, their seat during travel and their loads when getting off, and if they are disabled, according to their disability. ✓  
You should always get on from the front door and get off from the back door.
- ✓ In metro, bus, tram and similar vehicles with stops, you must prepare before the stop and get off the vehicle on time.
- ✓ Take into consideration the sensitivities of the society, avoid disturbing others and speaking loudly and slang. ✓  
You can reduce your carbon footprint and leave a cleaner world to future generations by choosing environmentally friendly means of transportation and public transportation (metro, train, etc. rail system and bus) during your visits.
