

MUSEUM VISIT GUIDELINES

- Unless otherwise stated, touching the exhibits or crossing safety barriers is strictly prohibited.
 - Non-professional photography for personal use is permitted for souvenir purposes. Photographs must be taken **without flash** and **without the use of tripods or selfie sticks**.
 - We kindly ask our visitors to refrain from speaking loudly and from making mobile phone calls within the exhibition areas.
 - Food and beverages are not permitted inside the exhibition halls.
 - Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes, is strictly prohibited in both indoor and outdoor areas of the museum.
 - Children under the age of 12 may visit the museum only when accompanied by an adult.
 - Running inside the museum premises is not permitted.

GUIDELINES FOR VISITS TO FOREST AND NATURAL AREAS

- Please observe the designated opening and closing hours.
 - The use of cigarettes and tobacco products is strictly prohibited.
 - Littering the area with water bottles, cigarette butts, food packaging, plastic bags, or any other waste is strictly forbidden.
 - Lighting fires is not permitted.
 - During tours, making excessive noise or playing loud music is not allowed.
 - Entry is not permitted to areas under strict protection due to endangered species, or to locations considered unsafe for general security reasons.
 - Visitors must remain within designated areas and routes in protected zones. This rule is essential both for the conservation of natural resources and for visitor safety.
