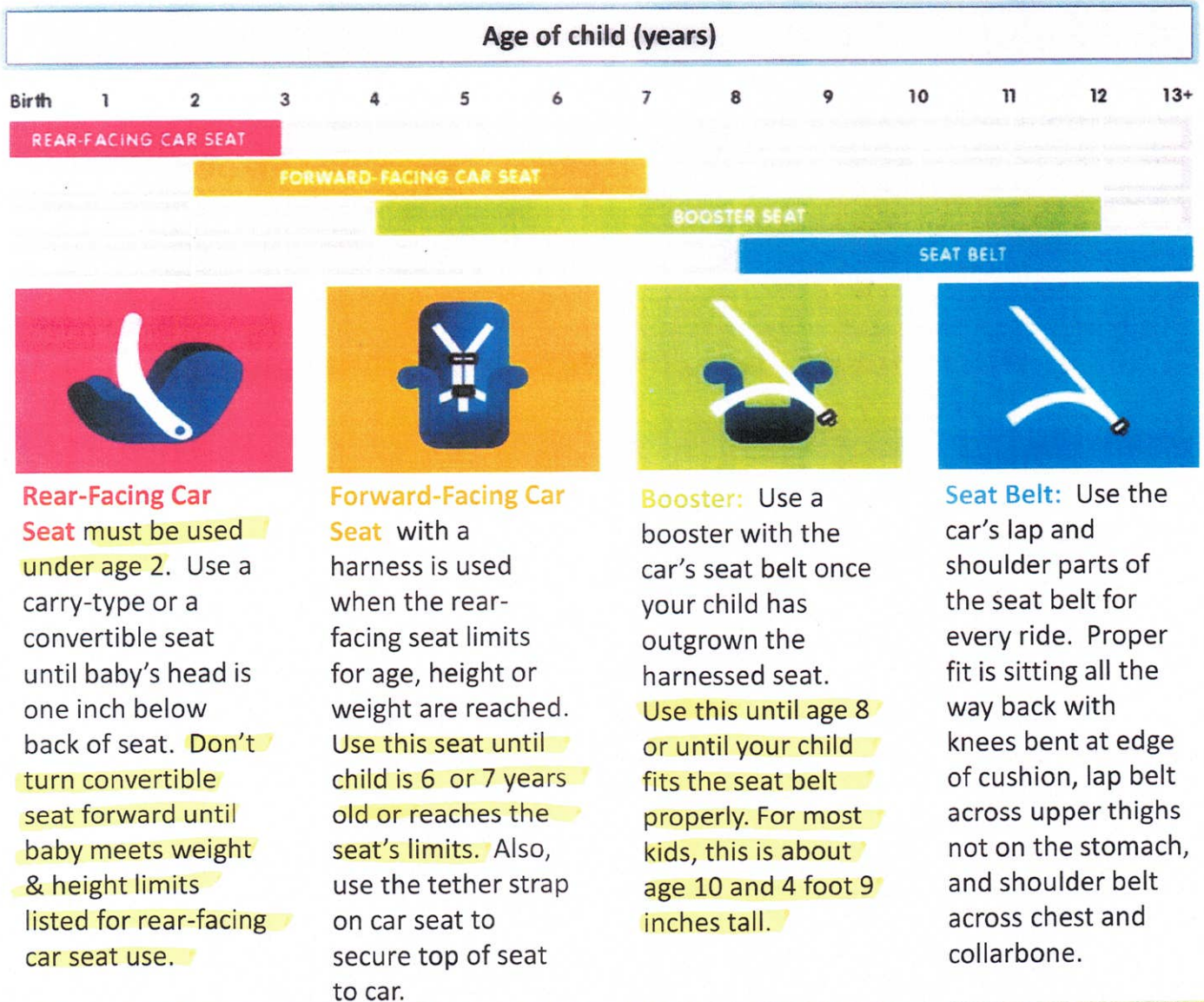


Car seats, booster seats, and seat belts keep children safe in the car



Maryland requires children under 8 years old to ride in a car seat unless the child is 4 feet, 9 inches or taller. Every child ages 8 - 16 years old not in a car seat must use a seat belt. Children under age 2 must ride in a rear-facing car seat until they reach the seat's height/weight limit.
