#### **Cremation Services Explained**

All our cremation service packages are designed for simplicity, ease, and with a budget in mind. Our estimated total cremation service price includes HST, disbursements, a temporary cremation container, pacemaker removal and much more than just the "basic" items your family will need to complete the funeral. Usually, the cremation takes place before any of the optional services are completed, and of course we include some private time for your family to say goodbye. The options are endless, and we can discuss them in full detail with you when you are ready. To keep our prices upfront and clear, we have broken down cremation services into four categories: IF THE DECEDENT PASSED AWAY FROM

## COVID-19, THEN MINIMUM CONTAINER FOR CREMATION IS MDF PINE CONTAINER \$495.

- 1. Simple this service is the simplest that we offer. It entrusts the body of your loved one to us. We will care for them and accompany them to their final place of rest. Once the cremation is complete, we will contact the next of kin and return the ashes to them in a temporary container. Proof of Death Certificates are provided along with a consultation with one of our funeral directors to complete the aftercare program.
- 2. Witnessing can be organized should a family want to see the casket placed into the cremation chamber and witness the beginning of the cremation process. This would be completed by meeting your family at the crematorium. It may be very difficult for some to be part of this process; therefore, we suggest that only a few people attend, and you fully understand what is happening prior to your arrival. One of our funeral directors will explain everything to your family should you wish to have this option. Once the cremation is complete, we will contact the next of kin and return the ashes to them in a temporary container. Proof of Death Certificates are provided along with a consultation with one of our funeral directors to complete the aftercare program. TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED
- 3. **Social** is selected most often by families who wish to have a less formal gathering. It begins with the cremation taking place, and the remains being placed into an urn. A two-hour gathering to celebrate and honor your loved one's life is held entirely in our reception area with the urn present. Your loved one's favorite music can be played; catering and refreshments may be made available and guests are invited to share stories and memories. Our funeral directors can offer suggestions for personalization and can completely take away the stress of organizing a funeral. Proof of Death Certificates are provided along with a consultation with one of our funeral directors to complete the aftercare program.
- 4. Memorial can be organized to take place following the cremation if the family would like to have a formal service, either religious or non-denominational. The urn is usually present, and our funeral directors will coordinate and host the entire event. Memorials keep funeral costs to a minimum while still allowing for a formal service. Holding the service within the funeral home would allow for the most flexibility in time selection. Traditionally, chapel services are held early in the morning, but evening vigils are becoming more popular because it allows guests to have a regular day of work and still have time to attend the funeral. An example of timing for this style of funeral would be 6:00-7:00 p.m. gathering, followed by a formal service beginning at 7:00 p.m. and concluding at approximately 8:00p.m.

Notes and Options Pertaining to Cremation Services: The normal cremation process usually takes between 4 - 5 business days to complete, however the time frame may change based on the crematorium, their availability, their hours of operation, the coroner's availability, and the time of death. An expedited cremation (2 business days) may be completed for an additional \$195. Delivery of remains is included within 40 kms – one way – additional mileage is billed at \$1.95 km thereafter. Distance calculated from the funeral homes address. Additional fees apply to removals that require more than one person.

The Private family ID is set up and organized to allow the next of kin a chance to say goodbye. Only the most immediate family is invited to attend (Maximum of 10 people for a maximum of 30 minutes. We suggest this happen as soon as possible unless embalming is completed. Should your family wish to add embalming to allow for a private visitation the pricing options are as follows; Additional \$250 for embalming. If your family chooses to use a visitation chapel, a fee of \$890 applies. The use of lounge facilities is not included in a private family ID but can be used for a fee of \$150.00 for 30 minutes.

Our simple services include a visitation period of up to 4 hours only. The stationery included with this package is limited to the simple stationery package option. The simple service does not include the items listed with the Standard Stationery Package or the complimentary items listed on page 6 and 7 of this price list. This package only includes one staff member to work the visitation. No doorperson, no golf cart shuttle service, no room attendant, no concierge service, or premium staff services. This package also does not include personalized hand sanitizers or facemasks, lasagna after funeral arrangements, in room coffee service, crucifix pouch, casket blanket, artificial flower arrangement for crypt, personalized bookmarks, DVD slideshow, visor frame, 11 X 14 canvas photo, holiday ornament, bottled water, eternity blanket, angel pins, and pallbearer items. Use of espresso lounge, photo boards, and the completion of aftercare paperwork is included.



#### **Co-Ordinating activities and ceremonies**

From the initial call to inform us about the need for our services until months after the funeral is complete, our staff is here for you. We provide professional consultation which includes, but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet all of your needs.

Co-ordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as flowers, catering and death notices.

#### **Documentation**

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation. 10 Proof of Death certificates are issued by the funeral home and if more copies are required, we will provide them at no charge.

#### Transfer of the deceased

Transportation of the remains from one place to another, for example from the home or hospital to the funeral home or the funeral home to the cemetery or crematorium, within a 40 km radius of the funeral home. A charge applies for each transportation request. The transfer of the loved one is a 24-hour service. For any transfer that requires 2 staff members, an additional charge of \$200 applies.

#### \*Basic preparation of remains

The basic preparation of the body includes placing your loved one into the selected casket or container, bathing, dressing, cosmetics are usually not applied, ensuring the eyes, mouth and hands are positioned appropriately for identification, and hair brushing or combing.

Pacemaker/radioactive device removal, if applicable. Hair

Styling and Hair tinting are available for an additional fee starting from \$150.

#### **Embalming**

Embalming is the process of replacing bodily fluids with a chemical preservative called formaldehyde. Although there are no legal requirements for embalming, it is highly recommended to allow for a traditional visitation period. Includes Basic Preparation of Remains.

Additional fee of \$650 applies for those who have passed away from an infectious/contagious disease. Additional fee of \$150 applies for those being shipped out of the province or country.

#### Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter

We have designated a specific room in our building which serves as a preparation room and a dignified holding facility.

\* This fee is charged in addition to Basic preparation of Remains and/or embalming

#### Staff services for visitation

Our employees help guide your guests to your visitation suite, control large crowds, place floral tributes into visitation suites, customize your seating arrangements, and are at your service through the entire process to oversee the visitation sessions.

#### Staff services for ceremony

Our funeral directors and assistants coordinate the funeral service start and departure time. Make various announcements if required and offer structure and organization to the day of the funeral service.

#### **Facilities for visitation**

Our facilities include four spacious visitation suites to choose from, a staffed espresso refreshment lounge, and ample parking.

Requires staff services for visitation.

#### **Facilities for ceremony**

The suites can also be transformed into chapels, which can accommodate anywhere between 60 - 120 guests. These setups are often used for memorial celebrations or short prayer services.

Requires staff services for ceremony.

#### **Ship out of Province or Country**

We can facilitate the shipment of a body to or from any province or country in the world. Each country and consulate have specific requirements for transporting human remains and/or cremated remains as well as a specific time frame for the processing of documents.

#### **Reception Facilities**

Designated facilities used for the post funeral reception for up to 2 hours or short gatherings between visitations. Funeral receptions provide an ideal opportunity for family and friends to commemorate the loved one's life. A reception at our funeral home frees you from the worries of organizing a facility to host this gathering. We provide regular coffee, espresso, tea, bottled water, soft drinks, napkins, dinnerware, and cutlery for 40 - 170 people as part of this service.

Use of reception rooms are subject to availability – Room rentals vary from \$300 - \$1,100

#### Hostess services for reception

Our staff will organize your private reception space for your guests, help with the setup of food and beverages, clearing tables of plates, cutlery cleaning of the reception area and will be made available to organize the food and beverages. All receptions must use our hostess facilities. Hostesses cost \$165 for up to 3 hours.

Additional fees apply after 3 hours.

#### **Aftercare**

In keeping with our commitment to care for the families we serve, we are proud to offer a unique service known as Aftercare. This service is designed to help families deal with the many issues that arise after the funeral service has taken place. Services include assistance with filing for Canada Pension Plan: Death Benefit, Survivor's Pension, Child(rens) Benefits, Health Card Cancellation, SIN Number Cancellation, estate planning information and information regarding community resources that are available to the family, as well as assistance in

bereavement support. All aftercare is done by appointment only to better serve you.

#### **Disbursements**

All disbursements are billed to the purchaser at cost. This includes but is not limited to the clergy honorarium, organist fees, soloist fees, city registration fees, newspaper notices, trumpeter, coroner's fees, police escorts, crematorium fees, consular fees, and health department fees. All disbursements are estimates and the final total will change based on the third parties' invoices.

#### **Funeral Vehicles**

A five-passenger vehicle, funeral hearse, limousine, flower truck, and a utility van are all vehicles that are used on traditional services. The use of the vehicles may vary depending on your service selection. All of our vehicle pricing is based on the initial 40 kms – one way – additional mileage is billed at \$1.95 / km thereafter. All vehicles come with an experienced staff member to assist with various tasks on the funeral day. The removal of a vehicle from a package may result in additional staffing charges. Limousines are not included to wait for receptions and are included for a maximum 5-hour funeral.

Additional time may be requested by the family and will be billed at \$150 / hour.

Cancellation of a limousine will result in the addition of an additional non-licensed staff member for a 5-hour period \$85 x 5 = \$425. This person assists the funeral director with various duties such as: directing traffic in our parking lot, at the church and/or cemetery, opening of doors at the church and cemetery, guiding family and friends to various locations at the church and cemetery.

 A rental limousine service does not know the funeral business and typically will wait by the car and seldom open any doors. They do not help with placing of flowers, parking of any cars or retrieving funeral flags etc.

## Horse Drawn Carriage is subject to availability

The use of the Horse Drawn Carriage is for an hour and a half period. Using this service is done in a variety of ways:

1. is to go in procession from the funeral home to arrive at church or

2. using the carriage once inside the cemetery gates, the casket could be transferred into the horse drawn carriage and then proceed to the mausoleum or burial plot.

Using this service requires more time, especially when we are processing to a church from the funeral home.

The use of police escorts for this service is mandatory (police escorts are based on availability) to help with the slower procession speed and traffic congestion that we will be causing. If using this service at the cemetery only the use of police escorts is not necessary.
