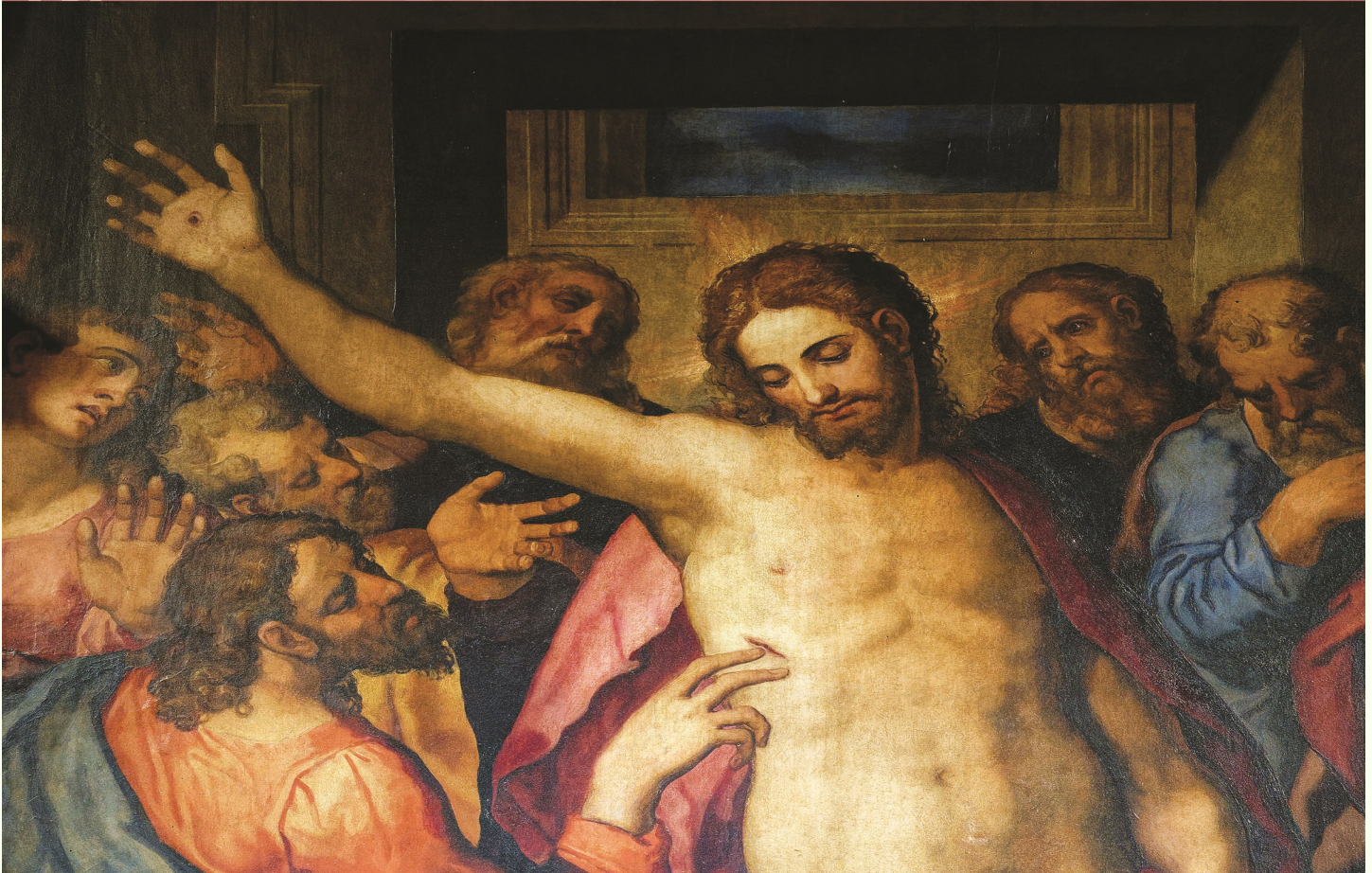

**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

Our annual "get out of jail free " card is available to all this Divine Mercy Sunday! On this day, Our Lord has stated." I will pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." The novena is an annual opportunity to gather and redeem all of mankind into the abode of God's mercy. It can be started even if late but should be completed by this Sunday with Confession within the Easter Octave. The Divine Mercy novena is a Catholic devotion centered on the belief that God's love is unlimited and available to all, particularly to the greatest sinners through trust in Jesus. To exemplify His mercy, Jesus appears before the cowering disciples, who were ashamed and sorrowful about abandoning their leader. They were amazed that Our Lord could be so forgiving despite their disloyalty and fear. He empowered them to "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." The institution of the sacrament of Confession is key for us and all to be accepted in the stronghold of the Mercy message. No matter what sins we have committed, we will be able to wipe the slate clean, restoring our Baptismal state of grace. "Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy."

**Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE**

¡Nuestra tarjeta anual de "salida libre de la cárcel" está disponible para todos en este Domingo de la Divina Misericordia! En este día, Nuestro Señor ha declarado: "Derramaré un océano entero de gracias sobre aquellas almas que se acerquen a la Fuente de Mi misericordia. El alma que acuda a la Confesión y reciba la Sagrada Comunión obtendrá el perdón total de sus pecados y de las penas debidas por ellos". La novena constituye una oportunidad anual para reunir y redimir a toda la humanidad, conduciéndola al refugio de la misericordia de Dios. Puede iniciarse incluso con retraso, pero debe completarse para este domingo, habiendo recibido la Confesión dentro de la Octava de Pascua. La novena de la Divina Misericordia es una devoción católica centrada en la creencia de que el amor de Dios es ilimitado y está al alcance de todos —particularmente de los más grandes pecadores— mediante la confianza en Jesús. Para ejemplificar Su misericordia, Jesús se aparece ante los discípulos atemorizados, quienes se sentían avergonzados y afligidos por haber abandonado a su Maestro. Quedaron asombrados de que Nuestro Señor pudiera ser tan indulgente a pesar de su deslealtad y su miedo. Él les otorgó el poder, diciendo: "Reciban el Espíritu Santo. A quienes perdonen los pecados, les quedarán perdonados; y a quienes se los retengan, les quedarán retenidos". La institución del sacramento de la Confesión es fundamental para que nosotros —y toda la humanidad— seamos acogidos en el baluarte del mensaje de la Misericordia. Sin importar qué pecados hayamos cometido, podremos hacer borrón y cuenta nueva, restaurando así nuestro estado de gracia bautismal. "La humanidad no hallará la paz hasta que se vuelva hacia la Fuente de Mi Misericordia".

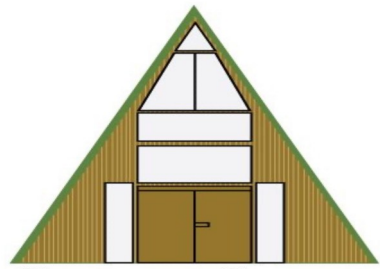
