



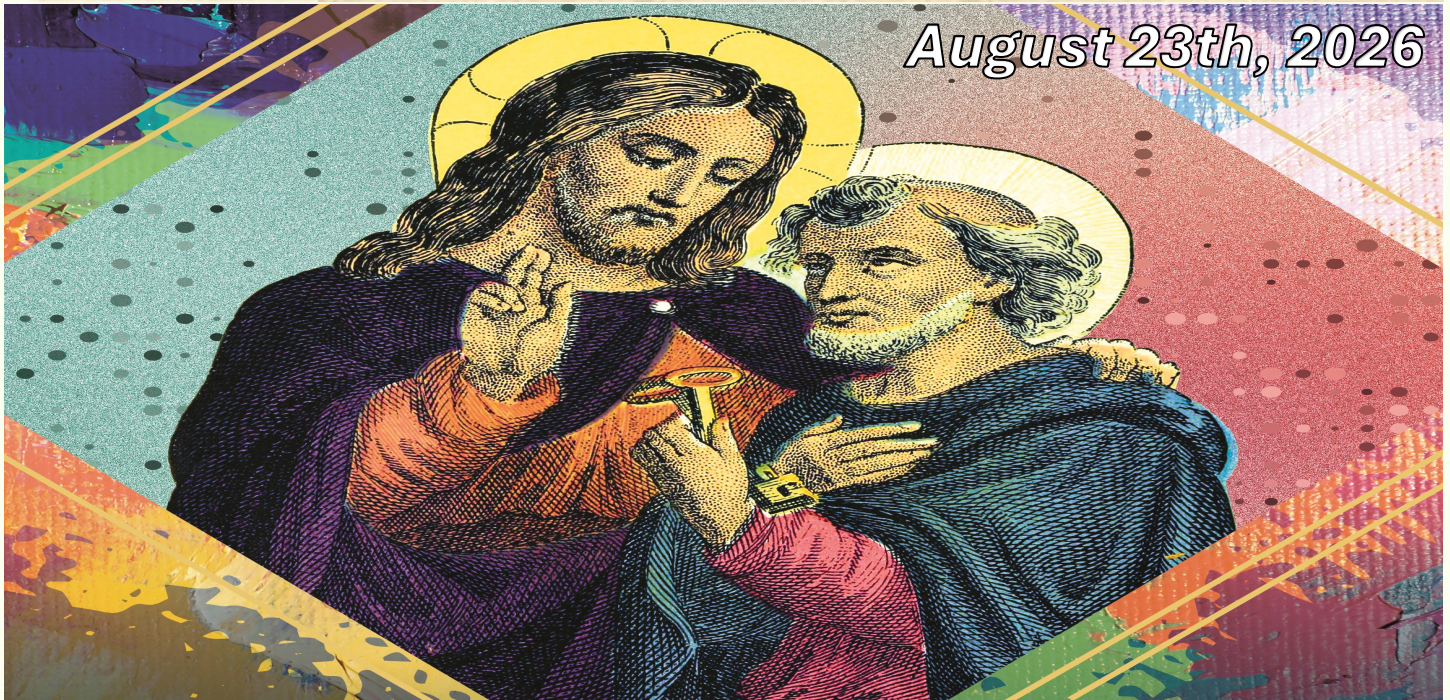

Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

The first poll took place in Caesara Philippi with Jesus' question "Who do you say that I am?" Christ pushes his disciples past public gossip and forces them to make a personal conscious declaration of faith regarding his true identity. Peter's response straight from the heart, stuns us even today. "You are the Messiah, the Son of the Living God." Jesus stated this response was directly from the Father, rather than from human reasoning. To me, the important take away for believers is that faith is moved from public opinion to personal choice. We can ask ourselves the same question- Who do we say that Jesus is : a prophet, a king, a priest, a redeemer? I choose the King of the Universe and choose to abide in His kingdom of the Catholic Church. Peter's response establishes Christ's foundation of the Catholic church and Peter as the first Pope. In Christ's own words, he singles out Peter, designating him as the head of the new Church he is establishing. From then on, all the apostles deferred to Peter in all matters of importance, leadership and decision making. It invites all hearers of this truth to make their own personal declaration of belief. Our Catechism says when Jesus gave Peter a unique position of preeminence among the apostles, it made him the supreme authority in the early Church. "Rome, the local church that Peter led became after his death the internal reference point of the young Church." Cohesive unity "in matters of faith and morals, guaranteed by the Church's Magisterium, or teaching authority, headed by the Pope is one reason for the remarkable resilience and influence of the Catholic Church. "

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

La primera «encuesta» tuvo lugar en Cesarea de Filipo con la pregunta de Jesús: «¿Quién decís que soy yo?». Cristo lleva a sus discípulos más allá de los rumores públicos y los obliga a hacer una declaración de fe personal y consciente sobre su verdadera identidad. La respuesta de Pedro, nacida directamente del corazón, nos asombra incluso hoy: «Tú eres el Mesías, el Hijo del Dios vivo». Jesús afirmó que esta respuesta provenía directamente del Padre, y no del razonamiento humano. Para mí, la lección importante para los creyentes es que la fe pasa de ser una opinión pública a convertirse en una elección personal. Podemos hacernos la misma pregunta: ¿Quién decimos que es Jesús? ¿Un profeta, un rey, un sacerdote, un redentor? Yo elijo al Rey del Universo y decido permanecer en su reino, la Iglesia Católica. La respuesta de Pedro establece el fundamento de Cristo para la Iglesia Católica y sitúa a Pedro como el primer Papa. En palabras del propio Cristo, él distingue a Pedro, designándolo como cabeza de la nueva Iglesia que está fundando. Desde entonces, todos los apóstoles acudían a Pedro en todos los asuntos de importancia, liderazgo y toma de decisiones. Esto invita a todos los que escuchan esta verdad a hacer su propia declaración personal de fe. Nuestro Catecismo afirma que, al otorgar a Pedro una posición única de preeminencia entre los apóstoles, Jesús lo convirtió en la autoridad suprema de la Iglesia primitiva. «Roma, la iglesia local que Pedro presidió, se convirtió tras su muerte en el punto de referencia interno de la joven Iglesia». La unidad cohesiva «en materia de fe y moral, garantizada por el Magisterio de la Iglesia —es decir, su autoridad docente encabezada por el Papa—, es una de las razones de la extraordinaria fortaleza e influencia de la Iglesia Católica».

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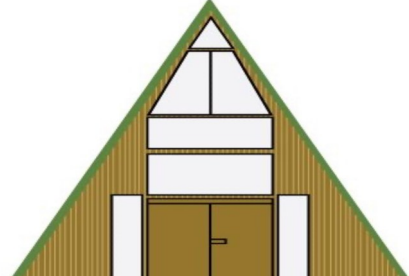
