Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

When I was ten, my dad gathered our family around the table in small-town Vermont and told us we were moving to the big desert city of Phoenix, Arizona. We were leaving behind family, friends, and everything familiar. None of us knew what to expect.

But something beautiful happened. As we made the move together, our family grew closer. In retrospect, I'm amazed at my parents' courage to go on that adventure. Even as a kid I realized our family found, in that challenge, a deeper unity and mutual love.

In today's Gospel, Joseph is told: **"Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee..." (Matthew 2:13, 20).** First to Egypt, then later to Israel. The Holy Family is frequently challenged to move and change, to adapt to God's will for them, in order to find safety in the midst of threat. It's not just an idiosyncratic story about survival. It's a spiritual pattern for all of us. Every Christian family is called to be a kind of sanctuary, especially in a world full of noise, busyness, and fear.

May I make a practical application for us? The Lord's Day, Sunday, is perhaps the most practical way we imitate this dynamic we see in Joseph and his family. Sunday is not meant to be just like every other day, filled with errands and stress. It's meant to be a day set apart; a holy "escape" into rest, worship, joy, and peace. A day to rise, take your family, and flee, into God's presence.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

Cuando tenía diez años, mi padre reunió a nuestra familia alrededor de la mesa en un pequeño pueblo de Vermont y nos dijo que nos mudaríamos a la gran ciudad desértica de Phoenix, Arizona. Dejaríamos atrás a la familia, a los amigos y todo lo que nos era familiar. Ninguno de nosotros sabía qué esperar.

Pero sucedió algo hermoso. Al mudarnos juntos, nuestra familia se unió aún más. En retrospectiva, me asombra el valor de mis padres al emprender esa aventura. Incluso de niño me di cuenta de que nuestra familia encontró, en ese desafío, una unidad y un amor mutuo más profundos.

En el Evangelio de hoy, a José se le dice: **«Levántate, toma al niño y a su madre, y huye...» (Mateo 2:13, 20).** Primero a Egipto, y luego a Israel. La Sagrada Familia se ve frecuentemente obligada a mudarse y a adaptarse a la voluntad de Dios, para encontrar seguridad en medio de la amenaza. No se trata solo de una historia particular de supervivencia. Es un modelo espiritual para todos nosotros. Toda familia cristiana está llamada a ser una especie de santuario, especialmente en un mundo lleno de ruido, ajetreo y miedo.

¿Puedo hacer una aplicación práctica para nosotros? El Día del Señor, el domingo, es quizás la forma más práctica de imitar esta dinámica que vemos en José y su familia. El domingo no debe ser un día cualquiera, lleno de recados y estrés. Debe ser un día especial; una «escapada» sagrada para descansar, adorar, disfrutar y encontrar la paz. Un día para levantarse, tomar a la familia y huir a la presencia de Dios.
