Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

The Peace theme of this week's gospel seems to contradict the message. It is odd that the gospel compels us to rectify our sinful ways, yet we are called to peace. John's message of "Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand," seems to conflict with peaceful hope in Jesus' coming. How can we reconcile the two extremes? To have a clean heart during Advent, compels us to repent of anything that causes us to stumble. But what is repentance? We are to turn our backs on sin or those things leading us away from God. We are called to rectify our sinful ways, yet how many of us can identify exactly what those things are? Negative influences, gossiping friends, sinful pictures and movies that tempt us to lustful thoughts, jealousy and anger can all claim a place in why we need confession. The quest to have a secular Christmas, full of Santa, reindeer and jingle bells rather than Jesus' nativity, can mislead us. The money driven shopping to find the perfect gift for loved ones can make us too busy to contemplate the reason for the season. The crowded social obligations of Christmas can rob our peace, making us so busy cramming all the events into our otherwise peaceful calendar. The compulsion to hurry through the season and get through it, and then pull down all the decorations on the 26th is missing the point. Moving on to the next big thing is contrary to relishing the peace of Advent preparations. We are simply to ask God to illuminate the things that are not good in our lives. He will show us in His time, not ours.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

El tema de la paz en el evangelio de esta semana parece contradecir el mensaje. Es curioso que el evangelio nos impulse a corregir nuestros caminos pecaminosos, y al mismo tiempo seamos llamados a la paz. El mensaje de Juan: "Arrepíentense, porque el reino de los cielos está cerca", parece estar en conflicto con la esperanza pacífica en la venida de Jesús. ¿Cómo podemos conciliar estos dos extremos? Tener un corazón puro durante el Adviento nos impulsa a arrepentirnos de todo aquello que nos hace tropezar. Pero, ¿qué es el arrepentimiento? Debemos dar la espalda al pecado o a aquellas cosas que nos alejan de Dios. Estamos llamados a corregir nuestros caminos pecaminosos, pero ¿cuántos de nosotros podemos identificar exactamente cuáles son esas cosas? Las influencias negativas, los amigos chismosos, las imágenes y películas pecaminosas que nos tientan a pensamientos lujuriosos, los celos y la ira pueden ser algunas de las razones por las que necesitamos la confesión. La búsqueda de una Navidad secular, llena de Papá Noel, renos y villancicos en lugar del nacimiento de Jesús, puede desviarnos. Las compras compulsivas para encontrar el regalo perfecto para nuestros seres queridos pueden mantenernos demasiado ocupados como para contemplar el verdadero significado de la Navidad. Las numerosas obligaciones sociales de la Navidad pueden robarnos la paz, manteniéndonos tan ocupados que apenas tenemos tiempo para reflexionar. La necesidad de apresurarnos durante la temporada navideña y terminar con ella cuanto antes, para luego quitar todas las decoraciones el día 26, es perder de vista lo esencial. Pasar rápidamente a la siguiente celebración es contrario a disfrutar de la paz de los preparativos del Adviento. Simplemente debemos pedirle a Dios que ilumine aquello que no está bien en nuestras vidas. Él nos lo mostrará a su debido tiempo, no al nuestro.
