Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

"But when you give alms, do not let your left hand know what your right is doing, so that your almsgiving may be secret, and your Father who sees in secret will repay you." The three hallmarks of Lent are Fasting, Almsgiving and prayer. Increased prayer is self-explanatory but holds promise because we can offer sacrifices along with it. Almsgiving requires some thought if on a limited budget. If one has a fixed income, one must wisely distribute discretionary funds. It is wise to practice all three, but special emphasis is placed on fasting. Types of fasting can vary and should be something which you enjoy. One can fast from a favorite food, drink, past time. sport, shopping, video games or Television. But fasting can also be replacing complaining with the virtue of gratefulness. Some examples of alternative fasting: Fast from judging others; feast on the Christ dwelling in them. Fast from emphasis on differences, feast on the unity of all life. Fast from words that pollute, feast on the phrases that purify. Fast from worry, feast on Divine order. Fast from gossip, feast on affirmation. Fast from bitterness, feast on forgiveness. And fast from self-concern, feast on compassion for others. And lastly, fast from discouragement, feast on hope. The season of Lent is here, providing us with so many opportunities to sow love and kindness in the world. Let's take advantage of the time.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

"Pero cuando des limosna, que no sepa tu izquierda lo que hace tu derecha, para que tu limosna sea secreta, y tu Padre que ve en lo secreto te lo recompense". Los tres elementos distintivos de la Cuaresma son el ayuno, la limosna y la oración. Aumentar la oración es evidente, pero es prometedor porque podemos ofrecer sacrificios junto con ella. Dar limosna requiere cierta reflexión si se cuenta con un presupuesto limitado. Si se tienen ingresos fijos, es necesario distribuir sabiamente los fondos discrecionales. Es prudente practicar las tres, pero se hace especial hincapié en el ayuno. Los tipos de ayuno pueden variar y deben ser algo que se disfrute. Se puede ayunar de una comida, bebida, pasatiempo favorito, deporte, compras, videojuegos o televisión. Pero el ayuno también puede ser reemplazar las quejas por la virtud de la gratitud. Algunos ejemplos de ayuno alternativo: ayunar de juzgar a los demás; deleitarse en el Cristo que mora en ellos. ayunar del énfasis en las diferencias; deleitarse en la unidad de toda la vida. ayunar de las palabras que contaminan; deleitarse en las frases que purifican. Ayuna de la preocupación, deléitate en el orden divino. Ayuna del chisme, deléitate en la afirmación. Ayuna de la amargura, deléitate en el perdón. Y ayuna del egocentrismo, deléitate en la compasión por los demás. Y, por último, ayuna del desánimo, deléitate en la esperanza. La Cuaresma ya está aquí, brindándonos muchas oportunidades para sembrar amor y bondad en el mundo. Aprovechemos este tiempo.




