**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

Jesus defies the Pharisees, who taught that poverty or bad health was a punishment from God, by announcing the Beatitudes. These "blessings" were open to all young, impoverished or old and sick. Jesus gave positive exhortations to live in a way that keeps us close to himself. The poor in spirit are those who have material possessions, but who are ready to give them up when self-sacrifice is demanded. The example of the apostles, dropping their nets to follow Jesus speaks to this beatitude. Sorrow or mourning over any loss of a dear person will be rewarded by God's fortification during trying times. "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth" is a little harder to understand. Unlike most, the meek accept and recognize the gifts God has given them with gratitude and patience and without complaint. "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness", is clearly understood as those who desire to do God's will. "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy" is also clear. The merciful meet the needs of others, whether they are sinners or saints. And rightfully so those who mercifully forgive, will be forgiven by Our Father. "Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see God," The pure of heart are those who live chaste lives and are free of earthly desires. "Blessed are the peacemakers" are those who go out of their way to mend disagreements. They work especially hard to reconcile sinners back to God. The last blessing of rewarding those persecuted for Christ's sake, will find joy and share in his Resurrection. Each beatitude has attached to it a promise of great rewards, yet some find it difficult to attain. Christ left us a great gift in the Holy Eucharist, which will allow us strength to fully commit to living as God intended.

"From God alone, all blessings flow. his goodness, his closeness, his mercy- that is blessing. "May the Lord bless you" is the shortest prayer of blessing." CCC [2626-2627]

**Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE**

Jesús desafiaba a los fariseos, quienes enseñaban que la pobreza o la mala salud eran un castigo de Dios, al proclamar las Bienaventuranzas. Estas "bendiciones" estaban abiertas a todos: jóvenes, pobres, ancianos y enfermos. Jesús nos exhortó a vivir de una manera que nos mantenga cerca de Él. Los pobres de espíritu son aquellos que poseen bienes materiales, pero que están dispuestos a renunciar a ellos cuando se les exige el sacrificio. El ejemplo de los apóstoles, que dejaron sus redes para seguir a Jesús, ilustra esta bienaventuranza. El dolor o el luto por la pérdida de un ser querido será recompensado con el consuelo de Dios en los momentos difíciles. "Bienaventurados los mansos, porque ellos heredarán la tierra" es un poco más difícil de comprender. A diferencia de la mayoría, los mansos aceptan y reconocen los dones que Dios les ha dado con gratitud y paciencia, sin quejarse.

"Bienaventurados los que tienen hambre y sed de justicia" se entiende claramente como aquellos que desean hacer la voluntad de Dios. "Bienaventurados los misericordiosos, porque ellos alcanzarán misericordia" también es claro. Los misericordiosos atienden las necesidades de los demás, sean pecadores o santos. Y con razón, quienes perdonan con misericordia serán perdonados por nuestro Padre. "Bienaventurados los limpios de corazón, porque ellos verán a Dios". Los limpios de corazón son aquellos que viven vidas castas y libres de deseos terrenales. "Bienaventurados los que trabajan por la paz" son aquellos que se esfuerzan por resolver los desacuerdos. Trabajan especialmente para reconciliar a los pecadores con Dios. La última bienaventuranza, que recompensa a quienes son perseguidos por causa de Cristo, les promete alegría y participación en su Resurrección. Cada bienaventuranza conlleva la promesa de grandes recompensas, aunque a algunos les resulta difícil alcanzarlas. Cristo nos dejó un gran don en la Sagrada Eucaristía, que nos da la fuerza para comprometernos plenamente a vivir como Dios lo desea. "De Dios solo provienen todas las bendiciones: su bondad, su cercanía, su misericordia, eso es bendición.




