**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

Jesus, proclaimed as Son of God at his baptism, is subjected to a triple temptation. Obedience to the Father is a characteristic of true sonship, and Jesus is tempted by the devil to rebel against God, subtly in the first two attempts and blatantly in the third temptation. The language used is predicted in Deuteronomy centuries beforehand. So, the statements become more meaningful through Jesus' replies, confirming the New Testament as a fulfillment of the Old. It also may resemble Israel's disobedience when wandering in the desert. Recall that the Jews, God's firstborn sons, complained about the meager food, water and seemingly endless wandering. But to me it is likened more closely with Adam and Eve when tempted by Satan in the Garden of Eden. He first asked if the "forbidden fruit" looked good to eat, claiming that our first parents would become like gods (omnipotence). They were led to believe Satan's lies of power, immortality and omniscience. But when tempted, they succumbed and lost all three gifts of God to which they were entitled. The new Adam, Jesus however, does not give in to Satan's temptations regarding food, immortality and omniscience, as he already possessed all of the Father's gifts. The most important gift of obedience gave him the fortitude and will power to say no to all three temptations. When we are in the desert of Lent, sorely tempted to succumb to the many temptations around us, can we be as strong as Jesus? Or do we tend to become angry and "victimized" by our poor choices? We may claim that our needs are more important than sacrifices and resent having to do without anything. We must make God the primary source of our lives during Lent and turn to him in times of weakness and suffering. After I recognized that there is a God, it was impossible for me not to live for him alone."

**Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE**

Jesús, proclamado Hijo de Dios en su bautismo, es sometido a una triple tentación. La obediencia al Padre es característica de la verdadera filiación, y Jesús es tentado por el diablo a rebelarse contra Dios, sutilmente en los dos primeros intentos y descaradamente en la tercera tentación. El lenguaje empleado está predicho en Deuteronomio siglos antes. Así, las declaraciones cobran mayor significado a través de las respuestas de Jesús, confirmando el Nuevo Testamento como cumplimiento del Antiguo. También puede asemejarse a la desobediencia de Israel al vagar por el desierto. Recordemos que los judíos, los primogénitos de Dios, se quejaron de la escasez de comida y agua, y del vagabundeo aparentemente interminable. Pero para mí, se asemeja más a Adán y Eva cuando fueron tentados por Satanás en el Jardín del Edén. Primero preguntó si el "fruto prohibido" tenía buen aspecto, afirmando que nuestros primeros padres serían como dioses (omnipotencia). Fueron inducidos a creer las mentiras de Satanás sobre el poder, la inmortalidad y la omnisciencia. Pero al ser tentados, sucumbieron y perdieron los tres dones de Dios a los que tenían derecho. Sin embargo, el nuevo Adán, Jesús, no cede a las tentaciones de Satanás respecto a la comida, la inmortalidad y la omnisciencia, pues ya poseía todos los dones del Padre. El don más importante, la obediencia, le dio la fortaleza y la fuerza de voluntad para decir no a las tres tentaciones. Cuando estamos en el desierto de la Cuaresma, tentados a sucumbir a las muchas tentaciones que nos rodean, ¿podemos ser tan fuertes como Jesús? ¿O tendemos a enojarnos y a sentirnos víctimas de nuestras malas decisiones? Podemos afirmar que nuestras necesidades son más importantes que los sacrificios y resentir tener que prescindir de todo. Debemos hacer de Dios la fuente principal de nuestras vidas durante la Cuaresma y recurrir a él en momentos de debilidad y sufrimiento.

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
