**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

Being Salt and Light to others sounds complicated, but what does it mean? Being Salt and Light means followers of Jesus are called to positively influence the world by preserving morality. We are to add flavor through love and speaking truth to dispel darkness. This involves living with integrity, doing good works and showcasing God's kingdom, rather than just talking about it. Living holy lives in a sinful world is difficult. We are constantly bombarded with temptations, visually, auditory, emotionally and kinesthetically. But we are to ask the Holy Spirit's help in times of trial, to shore up our own weaknesses. Jesus knows we are weak, flawed human beings and need assistance. The Advocate is there for us, simply by calling upon Him. We further enhance our weak natures by frequenting the sacraments, bible study and fellowship. In order to be light to others, we must first know the scriptures ourselves. Because every day and every hour we are in danger of falling into sin and saying no to God, we beg Him not to leave us defenseless to the power of temptation. How does God's word influence our own lives? Are we able to lead others in prayer? Are we able to resist gossip and speak positively about those spoken negatively about? Are we demonstrating the Beatitudes? Are we following all the Commandments, not just the ones we like? We must examine our own ways of living out the Catholic faith.

Ser sal y luz para los demás suena complicado, pero ¿qué significa? Ser sal y luz significa que los seguidores de Jesús están llamados a influir positivamente en el mundo preservando la moralidad. Debemos añadir sabor a la vida a través del amor y proclamar la verdad para disipar la oscuridad. Esto implica vivir con integridad, hacer buenas obras y manifestar el reino de Dios, en lugar de solo hablar de él. Vivir una vida santa en un mundo pecaminoso es difícil. Constantemente somos bombardeados por tentaciones, visuales, auditivas, emocionales y físicas. Pero debemos pedir la ayuda del Espíritu Santo en los momentos de prueba, para fortalecer nuestras debilidades. Jesús sabe que somos seres humanos débiles e imperfectos y que necesitamos ayuda. El Paráclito está ahí para nosotros, simplemente con invocarlo. Fortalecemos nuestra naturaleza frágil frecuentando los sacramentos, el estudio de la Biblia y la comunidad. Para ser luz para los demás, primero debemos conocer las Escrituras nosotros mismos. Como cada día y cada hora corremos el peligro de caer en el pecado y decirle no a Dios, le rogamos que no nos deje indefensos ante el poder de la tentación. ¿Cómo influye la palabra de Dios en nuestras vidas? ¿Somos capaces de guiar a otros en la oración? ¿Somos capaces de resistir el chisme y hablar positivamente de aquellos de quienes se habla negativamente? ¿Estamos viviendo las Bienaventuranzas? ¿Estamos cumpliendo todos los Mandamientos, no solo los que nos gustan? Debemos examinar nuestra propia forma de vivir la fe católica.




