Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Today's gospel gives us a bird's eye view of how Jesus called his apostles. When Jesus heard of John's arrest, he withdrew and went to live by the sea. He must have reflected on the sorrowful arrest of John and on the "land of Naphtali, the Galilee of the Gentiles." This infamous place was a dark defeat for Israel as the Assyrians had demolished and deported many from there. Starting his ministry there, fulfilled Isaiah's promise of bringing "a great light" to a land overshadowed by death. Jesus transfers this sorrow into joy by stating that the Kingdom of God is at hand, therefore repent and seek God. Christ's recruitment of ordinary fisherman must have seemed random, yet he commanded respect and prompt obedience. "Come follow me and I will make you fishers of men." Something about this charismatic call must have been so impactful, so extraordinary, that men would leave behind their families, homes and income to follow. The call must have signaled great leadership, authority and adventure for the apostles to instantly follow him. We are not rough and strong fishermen, but do we let Jesus use our gifts to increase his Kingdom? Our Catechism says the apostles became witnesses of Jesus' Resurrection and guarantors of the truth about him. We can also be his witnesses in Catholic ministry, as we have a cloud of witness to back us. Are we able to drop our nets and follow Jesus?

El evangelio de hoy nos ofrece una visión general de cómo Jesús llamó a sus apóstoles. Cuando Jesús se enteró del arresto de Juan, se retiró y se fue a vivir junto al mar. Debió haber reflexionado sobre el triste arresto de Juan y sobre la "tierra de Neftalí, la Galilea de los gentiles". Este lugar, de infame reputación, representó una amarga derrota para Israel, ya que los asirios lo habían devastado y deportado a muchos de sus habitantes. Al comenzar su ministerio allí, Jesús cumplió la promesa de Isaías de traer "una gran luz" a una tierra ensombrecida por la muerte. Jesús transforma esta tristeza en alegría al anunciar que el Reino de Dios está cerca; por lo tanto, arrepentíos y buscad a Dios. El hecho de que Cristo reclutara a pescadores comunes debió parecer casual, sin embargo, infundió respeto y obtuvo obediencia inmediata. "Venid conmigo y os haré pescadores de hombres". Algo en este llamado carismático debió ser tan impactante, tan extraordinario, que aquellos hombres dejaron atrás a sus familias, sus hogares y sus medios de vida para seguirlo. El llamado debió transmitir un gran liderazgo, autoridad y la promesa de una gran aventura para que los apóstoles lo siguieran al instante. No somos pescadores rudos y fuertes, pero ¿permitimos que Jesús use nuestros dones para extender su Reino? Nuestro Catecismo dice que los apóstoles se convirtieron en testigos de la Resurrección de Jesús y garantes de la verdad sobre Él. Nosotros también podemos ser sus testigos en el ministerio católico, ya que contamos con una gran multitud de testigos que nos respaldan. ¿Somos capaces de dejar nuestras redes y seguir a Jesús?

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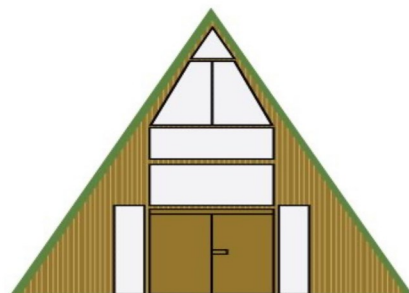
