Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Of all God's many gifts, wisdom seems the most sought after. Because with it, we better know God and his divine perfections. We can choose what is good and right coupled with good judgement. With this gift, we can go beyond our natural aptitudes and become God's special instruments in this world. Our Catechism stresses that wisdom needs to be prioritized and not just some random request, but sought more than silver or gold. We need wisdom to aspire to heaven, because without it we will make many wrong decisions. God's gifts of wisdom, faith and potential for heaven are worth more than anything else we could ever own. These gifts bring life, joy, and strength whenever we seek them with open hearts. Solomon shows us what it means to ask for the right thing. Instead of wealth, power, and success, he asks for wisdom to guide a "vast" amount of people, thereby gaining all he did not ask for as well as what he did request. Because he chose wisely, he became the most powerful political force in the known world at that time. In the gospel we are given several examples of finding treasure in which nothing else compares. Heaven costs everything, it means to give up whatever we have to gain its entrance. We need to want it more than all the goods of this world, because nothing else compares. Heaven is that pearl of great price, the only thing worth seeking. We are reminded to seek what lasts, not what fades away.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

De entre los muchos dones de Dios, la sabiduría parece ser el más anhelado. Pues gracias a ella, conocemos mejor a Dios y sus perfecciones divinas. Podemos elegir lo que es bueno y correcto, actuando con buen juicio. Con este don, somos capaces de trascender nuestras aptitudes naturales y convertirnos en instrumentos especiales de Dios en este mundo. Nuestro Catecismo subraya que la sabiduría debe ser una prioridad; no ha de pedirse al azar, sino buscarse con mayor ahínco que la plata o el oro. Necesitamos la sabiduría para aspirar al cielo, ya que, sin ella, tomaríamos muchas decisiones equivocadas. Los dones divinos de la sabiduría, la fe y la promesa del cielo valen más que cualquier otra cosa que podamos poseer. Estos dones nos aportan vida, alegría y fortaleza siempre que los buscamos con el corazón abierto. Salomón nos enseña lo que significa pedir lo correcto. En lugar de riquezas, poder o éxito, pide sabiduría para guiar a una multitud inmensa; así, obtiene tanto aquello que no había pedido como lo que sí solicitó. Al elegir sabiamente, se convirtió en la fuerza política más poderosa del mundo conocido de su época. En el Evangelio encontramos varios ejemplos sobre el hallazgo de un tesoro con el que nada más puede compararse. El cielo lo exige todo; implica renunciar a cuanto tenemos para lograr entrar en él. Debemos desearlo más que todos los bienes de este mundo, pues nada más se le equipara. El cielo es esa perla de gran valor, lo único que realmente vale la pena buscar. Se nos recuerda que debemos buscar aquello que perdura, no lo que se desvanece.

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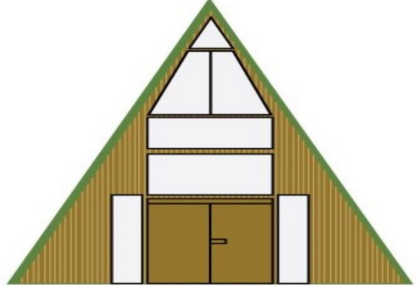

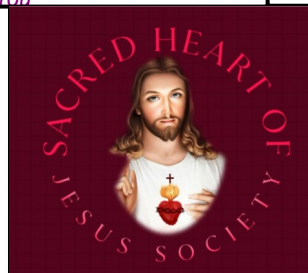
