### Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Besides celebrating the birthday of our country, bringing freedom from tyranny, we want freedom from sin. Today's gospel is another mysterious teaching of Jesus in freeing ourselves of this plague. "Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart." What exactly does this mean? Meekness is not groveling low or shying away from the public eye. In Christ's time, meekness implied strength under control with the intellect controlling emotion. He reached out to the wounded, the broken and the humble, not the proud, the haughty or the esteemed. To understand Christ more fully, imagine being alive during his time. Would it have been easier to understand and fulfill his teachings if we heard it from His mouth? I think yes because we could read his body language, nuance of speech and gestures. But then again, he had much more opposition to speaking the truth, then we do now. Jesus had to endure political opposition in the form of Sadducees, Pharisees, Essences and Revolutionaries. In addition, the entire country was occupied by pagan Roman soldiers, under their control monetarily, societally and politically. Recall that at Christ's death, the apostles were in hiding, afraid to show their faces for fear of persecution. In addition, Christ was also born in poverty, having to pay Caesar his due with no visible income. Despite these restrictions, Christ still fulfilled the Father's mission of salvation for us through following himself... When we drop our pride and become "humble of heart", we will find Christ's yoke is easy and our burden's lighter.

"Even saints went to confession regularly, if possible. They needed it in order to grow in humility and charity, so as to allow themselves to be touched by God's healing light even in the inmost recesses of their souls." CCC 1458

### Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

Además de celebrar el nacimiento de nuestra nación —que nos liberó de la tiranía—, anhelamos la libertad frente al pecado. El Evangelio de hoy nos presenta otra enseñanza misteriosa de Jesús sobre cómo liberarnos de esta lacra: «Cargad con mi yugo y aprended de mí, que soy manso y humilde de corazón». ¿Qué significa esto exactamente? La mansedumbre no consiste en humillarse servilmente ni en evitar la mirada pública. En tiempos de Cristo, la mansedumbre implicaba una fuerza bajo control, donde el intelecto dominaba a la emoción. Él se acercaba a los heridos, a los quebrantados y a los humildes, no a los orgullosos, a los soberbios ni a los poderosos. Para comprender mejor a Cristo, imaginemos que vivimos en su época. ¿Habría sido más fácil entender y cumplir sus enseñanzas si las hubiéramos escuchado directamente de sus labios? Creo que sí, pues habríamos podido percibir su lenguaje corporal, los matices de su voz y sus gestos. Sin embargo, él enfrentó mucha más oposición al proclamar la verdad de la que nosotros encontramos hoy. Jesús tuvo que soportar la oposición política de saduceos, fariseos, esenios y revolucionarios. Además, el país entero estaba ocupado por soldados romanos paganos, bajo cuyo control se hallaban los aspectos económicos, sociales y políticos. Recordemos que, tras la muerte de Cristo, los apóstoles permanecían ocultos, temerosos de dejarse ver por miedo a la persecución. Asimismo, Cristo nació en la pobreza y tuvo que pagar el tributo al César sin contar con ingresos visibles. A pesar de estas limitaciones, Cristo cumplió la misión de salvación que el Padre le encomendó para nosotros, invitándonos a seguirle... Cuando dejamos de lado el orgullo y nos volvemos «humildes de corazón», descubrimos que el yugo de Cristo es suave y nuestra carga, más ligera. «Incluso los santos acudían a confesarse con regularidad, siempre que fuera posible. Lo necesitaban para crecer en humildad y caridad, permitiendo así que la luz sanadora de Dios llegara hasta lo más profundo de sus almas». CIC 1458

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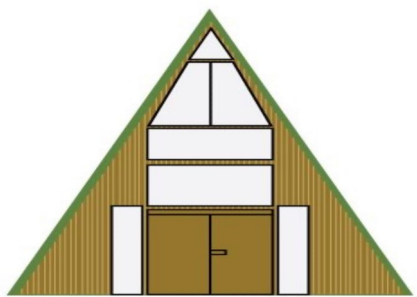
