Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

As I age not always gracefully, I ponder how God can let so many "counted hairs on my head" be shed. Of course, the Lord knows more about us than we know of ourselves. The quandary of daily losing much hair remains another mystery which may not be answered in this life. Just as the cost of discipleship is a mystery. God wants us to stand up as Christians, and do the right thing, when the situation demands. But we do not always know what that entails. Nor feel equipped to handle such a dilemma. We can acknowledge God in small ways. We know to turn off inappropriate movies, turn the other cheek in arguments and control our tempers. But we sometimes may succumb to gossip, laugh at inappropriate jokes or not correct others who take the name of the Lord in vain. We reserve work, errands and shopping for other days rather than Sunday. We try to get to regular Confession, but "fear of the Lord" is not always so clear cut. Fearing the Lord, a gift of the Holy Spirit, is rather wonder and awe at His creation. The gospel encourages us to deny ourselves, empowering us to live out the Christian life. Speaking boldly to defend our faith is difficult in these times of civil unrest because many want the things that Catholicism opposes. Even standing against abortion and the "hook up culture" is considered counter cultural. But our faith demands we stand for truth even when it is inconvenient. As Jesus says "Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father."

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

A medida que envejezco —no siempre con elegancia—, reflexiono sobre cómo Dios permite que se caigan tantos de los "cabellos contados" de mi cabeza. Por supuesto, el Señor sabe más de nosotros que nosotros mismos. El dilema de perder tanto cabello a diario sigue siendo otro misterio que tal vez no se resuelva en esta vida. Al igual que el costo del discipulado es un misterio. Dios quiere que nos mantengamos firmes como cristianos y hagamos lo correcto cuando la situación lo exija. Pero no siempre sabemos lo que eso implica, ni nos sentimos preparados para afrontar tal dilema. Podemos reconocer a Dios en las pequeñas cosas. Sabemos apagar películas inapropiadas, poner la otra mejilla en las discusiones y controlar nuestro temperamento. Sin embargo, a veces podemos caer en el chisme, reírnos de chistes inapropiados o dejar de corregir a quienes toman el nombre del Señor en vano. Reservamos el trabajo, los recados y las compras para otros días que no sean el domingo. Intentamos acudir regularmente a la confesión, pero el "temor del Señor" no siempre se entiende con claridad. El temor del Señor, un don del Espíritu Santo es más bien asombro y reverencia ante su creación. El Evangelio nos anima a negarnos a nosotros mismos, dándonos la fortaleza para vivir la vida cristiana. Hablar con valentía para defender nuestra fe resulta difícil en estos tiempos de agitación social, ya que muchos desean aquello a lo que el catolicismo se opone. Incluso oponerse al aborto y a la "cultura de los encuentros casuales" (*hook-up culture*) se considera contracultural. Pero nuestra fe exige que defendamos la verdad, aun cuando resulte incómodo. Como dice Jesús: "A quien me reconozca delante de los hombres, yo también lo reconoceré delante de mi Padre que está en los cielos; pero a quien me niegue delante de los hombres, yo también lo negaré delante de mi Padre que está en los cielos". "Aunque camine por el valle de la sombra de muerte, no temeré mal alguno, porque tú estás conmigo". Salmo 23, 4.

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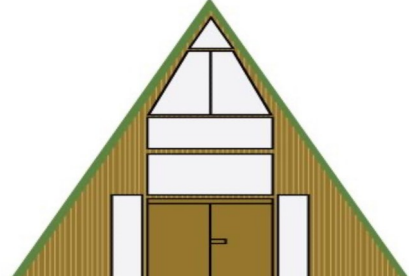
