Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Today's gospel is about priorities. If we put God first, all other decisions fall into place. If we put other things before God, like family, money, career, leisure, health, property, or material possessions, we eventually lose. None of these other things can bring happiness only true love and service to God. "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me." If we strive to love God above all, we are able to radiate God's love to the lesser priorities of life. Our job is to "pick up our cross" and follow Christ, which is not always easy. Many will say that if they just get a new job, a new house or a new acquisition, then they will be happy. But this thinking, leaves us empty after the initial joy wears off. No tangible thing can bring lasting happiness; only spiritual peace can. The second gospel emphasis is like the first, if we reject our neighbor, we reject Christ. "Whoever receives you, receives me and whoever rejects you, rejects me." So, if we harbor grudges and unforgiveness towards others, we are harboring a grudge against God. No endeavor can ultimately succeed if we are deliberately against God. Picking up our cross means we do the difficult, the painful, the tough things of life in spite of the inconvenience.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

El Evangelio de hoy trata sobre las prioridades. Si ponemos a Dios en primer lugar, todas las demás decisiones encuentran su lugar adecuado. Si anteponeamos otras cosas a Dios —como la familia, el dinero, la carrera, el ocio, la salud, las propiedades o las posesiones materiales—, a la larga saldremos perdiendo. Ninguna de estas cosas puede brindar felicidad; solo el amor verdadero y el servicio a Dios pueden hacerlo. «El que ama a su padre o a su madre más que a mí, no es digno de mí; y el que ama a su hijo o a su hija más que a mí, no es digno de mí». Si nos esforzamos por amar a Dios sobre todas las cosas, seremos capaces de irradiar el amor de Dios hacia las demás prioridades de la vida. Nuestra tarea consiste en «cargar con nuestra cruz» y seguir a Cristo, algo que no siempre resulta fácil. Muchos piensan que serán felices si consiguen un nuevo empleo, una casa nueva o alguna nueva adquisición; sin embargo, esta mentalidad nos deja vacíos una vez que se disipa la alegría inicial. Ningún bien material puede proporcionar una felicidad duradera; solo la paz espiritual lo logra. El segundo énfasis del Evangelio es similar al primero: si rechazamos al prójimo, rechazamos a Cristo. «Quien los recibe a ustedes, me recibe a mí; y quien los rechaza, me rechaza a mí». Por tanto, si albergamos rencor y falta de perdón hacia los demás, estamos guardando rencor contra Dios. Ninguna empresa puede prosperar verdaderamente si nos oponemos deliberadamente a Dios. Cargar con nuestra cruz significa afrontar lo difícil, lo doloroso y los aspectos más duros de la vida, a pesar de los inconvenientes.

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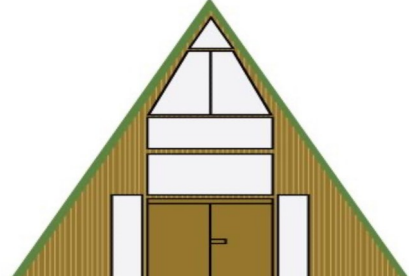
