Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

In John 6, "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life within you." This hard saying drove many from the early Church. It was the misconception that we must become cannibals or we can not be saved. Early followers were shocked at Christ's affirmation that one must eat His body and Blood, which was deemed unthinkable. However our catechism, explains the distinction: In every mass, Jesus' one perfect sacrifice on Calvary is represented sacramentally, made present in an unbloody manner and offered anew. (CCC 1366). By eating the Body of Christ, the Church becomes the Body of Christ, which is another name for the Church. Every Eucharist becomes the source of our Church from which she herself constantly springs anew. Jesus offers himself under the form of bread and wine "according to the priestly sacrificial order of Melchizedek (Cor. 11: 23-26). The feast of Corpus Christi, or the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a moveable feast. It celebrates the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist who sacrificed himself for the forgiveness of the sins we daily commit. The feast was established on the first Thursday after Trinity Sunday because that is when the Last Supper took place. At the Last Supper, Our Lord instituted the Eucharist, giving himself to his disciples under the form of bread and wine and commanded them from then on, to "Do this in remembrance of me." Rather than a weekday, the celebration is transferred to the following Sunday so that more can participate, enclosed within our Sunday obligation. Christ, the Lamb of God, truly offers himself so that we may have a new life in him. He loves us so much that he wants us to be close to him, so close that we ingest him. In this way we aspire to be the saints he has called us to be because Christ is living within us.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

En Juan 6 leemos: "Si no coméis la carne del Hijo del Hombre y no bebéis su sangre, no tenéis vida en vosotros". Esta afirmación difícil alejó a muchos en la Iglesia primitiva. Surgió la idea errónea de que debíamos convertirnos en caníbales para salvarnos. Los primeros seguidores se escandalizaron ante la afirmación de Cristo de que era necesario comer su Cuerpo y su Sangre, algo que se consideraba impensable. Sin embargo, nuestro Catecismo explica la distinción: en cada Misa, el único sacrificio perfecto de Jesús en el Calvario se representa sacramentalmente, se hace presente de manera incruenta y se ofrece de nuevo (CEC 1366). Al comer el Cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia se convierte en el Cuerpo de Cristo, que es otro nombre para la Iglesia misma. Cada Eucaristía se convierte en la fuente de nuestra Iglesia, de la cual ella misma renace constantemente. Jesús se ofrece bajo las especies de pan y vino "según el orden sacerdotal y sacrificial de Melchizedek" (1 Cor 11, 23-26). La fiesta del Corpus Christi, o Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, es una fiesta móvil. Celebra la Presencia Real de Cristo en la Eucaristía, quien se sacrificó por el perdón de los pecados que cometemos a diario. La fiesta se estableció el primer jueves después del Domingo de la Trinidad porque fue entonces cuando tuvo lugar la Última Cena. En la Última Cena, Nuestro Señor instituyó la Eucaristía, entregándose a sus discípulos bajo las especies de pan y vino, y les mandó que, en adelante, hicieran "esto en memoria mía". En lugar de celebrarse entre semana, la celebración se traslada al domingo siguiente para permitir una mayor participación, integrándose así en nuestra obligación dominical. Cristo, el Cordero de Dios, se ofrece verdaderamente para que tengamos una vida nueva en Él. Nos ama tanto que desea que estemos cerca de Él, tan cerca que lo recibimos en nuestro interior. De este modo, aspiramos a ser los santos que Él nos ha llamado a ser, porque Cristo vive en nosotros.
