**Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE**

Spiritual blindness refers to the inability to perceive or understand spiritual truths. This results from a lack of faith. It is described in the Bible as those individuals who can not see the light of the gospel. They are unable to recognize God's works and will. Just like being "dead in sin", before we come to know Jesus, we are spiritually blind before God opens our eyes to spiritual truths. We are unable to perceive them correctly. It is Christ who is the light of the world and He opens our eyes to the truth of who He is. Typically, Jesus challenges the leaders of the day with their false assumptions. Just like today, many "religious" leaders assume their righteousness will redeem them into heaven. Also, just as typical, is the false assumption that anyone born with a physical malady is somehow at fault because of his own sin. The gospel hearers ask Jesus, "who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" And Jesus answers rightly "neither he nor his parents sinned; it is so that the works of God might be made visible through him. Spiritual blindness is often linked to a hardened heart and the rejection of God's mission. This leads to a state of darkness in one's understanding and perception of spiritual realities. However, through faith in Jesus Christ, we can experience transformation and enlightenment, opening our eyes to the truth of God.

"Surely we are not blind, are we? Jesus said to them, "If you were blind, you would have not sin, but now you are saying, 'we see, so your sin remains.'" John 9: 37-38

**Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE**

En el ámbito espiritual, la ceguera se refiere a la incapacidad de percibir o comprender las verdades espirituales. Esto es consecuencia de la falta de fe. La Biblia la describe en referencia a aquellos individuos que no pueden ver la luz del evangelio; son incapaces de reconocer las obras y la voluntad de Dios. Al igual que estar «muertos en el pecado», antes de llegar a conocer a Jesús, nos encontramos espiritualmente ciegos hasta que Dios nos abre los ojos a las verdades espirituales. Somos incapaces de percibir las correctamente. Es Cristo quien es la luz del mundo, y Él nos abre los ojos a la verdad de quién es Él. Por lo general, Jesús desafía a los líderes de su tiempo respecto a sus falsas suposiciones. Al igual que hoy en día, muchos líderes «religiosos» asumen que su propia justicia será lo que los redima y les permita entrar en el cielo. Asimismo —y esto es algo también muy común— existe la falsa suposición de que cualquiera que nace con una dolencia física es, de algún modo, culpable a causa de su propio pecado. Quienes escuchan el evangelio le preguntan a Jesús: «¿Quién pecó: ¿este hombre o sus padres, para que haya nacido ciego?». Y Jesús responde con acierto: «Ni él pecó ni sus padres; esto sucedió para que las obras de Dios se hicieran visibles a través de él». La ceguera espiritual suele estar vinculada a un corazón endurecido y al rechazo de la misión de Dios. Esto conduce a un estado de oscuridad en la comprensión y percepción de las realidades espirituales. Sin embargo, mediante la fe en Jesucristo, podemos experimentar una transformación y una iluminación que nos abren los ojos a la verdad de Dios.

«¿Acaso también nosotros somos ciegos? Jesús les respondió: "Si fueran ciegos, no tendrían pecado; pero ahora dicen: 'Vemos', por lo tanto, su pecado permanece"». Juan 9:37-38
