Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Lent like the gospel today is a time to transform ourselves. Shed the old, time wasting futile habits and pick up new fruit bearing meaningful virtues. Christ was not transformed to please himself, but rather to show his disciples the hope that lay ahead. offsetting his persecution. Jesus was seen with Moses, representing the Law and Elijah representing the prophets with all three manifesting glorified bodies. The Transfiguration atop Mt. Tabor was a momentary foretaste of Paradise, giving the apostles the strength to endure what would come. Our Catechism says that the Father wanted to reveal the divine glory of his Son even during Jesus' earthly life {554-556}. Christ's Transfiguration was meant to help the disciples later to understand his death and Resurrection. Transfigured, Jesus wanted to show his disciples his glory, not for them to circumvent the cross, but rather to show where the cross ultimately leads. In making the harder choice to pick up our own crosses, we emulate Our Lord, willingly sacrificing, suffering and doing without in order to discipline our will. We deny ourselves pleasures and temptations that other times of the year we willingly enjoy. The purpose of Lent is to better know Our Lord, and ourselves, getting closer to what it means to live a simplified holy life. The late Pope Francis reflected many times that "those who die with Jesus, shall rise again with Jesus." Let us use our Lent wisely, even continuing our new found good habits long into the next year and perhaps forever.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

La Cuaresma, como el evangelio de hoy, es un tiempo para transformarnos. Despojarnos de los viejos hábitos inútiles que nos hacen perder el tiempo y recoger nuevas virtudes significativas que den fruto. Cristo no se transformó para complacerse a sí mismo, sino para mostrar a sus discípulos la esperanza que les esperaba, compensando su persecución. Jesús fue visto con Moisés, representando la Ley, y Elías representando a los profetas con los tres cuerpos glorificados manifestándose. La Transfiguración en la cima del Monte Tabor fue un anticipo momentáneo del Paraíso, dando a los apóstoles la fuerza para soportar lo que vendría. Nuestro Catecismo dice que el Padre quiso revelar la gloria divina de su Hijo incluso durante la vida terrenal de Jesús {554-556}. La Transfiguración de Cristo tenía como objetivo ayudar a los discípulos a comprender más tarde su muerte y resurrección. Transfigurado, Jesús quería mostrar a sus discípulos su gloria, no para que eludieran la cruz, sino para mostrar adónde conduce finalmente la cruz. Al tomar la difícil decisión de cargar con nuestras propias cruces, emulamos a Nuestro Señor, sacrificándonos, sufriendo y prescindiendo voluntariamente para disciplinar nuestra voluntad. Nos negamos placeres y tentaciones que en otras épocas del año disfrutamos voluntariamente. El propósito de la Cuaresma es conocer mejor a Nuestro Señor y a nosotros mismos, acercándonos a lo que significa vivir una vida sencilla y santa. El difunto Papa Francisco reflexionó muchas veces que «quien muere con Jesús, resucitará con Jesús». Usemos nuestra Cuaresma sabiamente, incluso continuando con nuestros nuevos buenos hábitos durante el próximo año y quizás para siempre. "La cruz no te aplastará: si su peso te hace tambalear, su poder también te sostendrá». San Padre Pío


