Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Today's gospel invites us to walk with Christ through the beginning of Holy Week until the final week of Lent. We walk with Jesus through his triumphant entry into Jerusalem, where palms are laid at his feet through his passion and Resurrection. How ironic that the martyr's palm is a symbol of spiritual victory or triumph over death. We see Our Lord in all of his humanity, lauded by admirers initially, then brutally executed as a criminal. He is fully human throughout these ordeals, even asking the Father to take away the cup of suffering that awaited him. But is it not like most of us who when confronted with pain, discomfort and death would ask for mercy? Suffering is repugnant to most people, who want to avoid it at costs, taking the easier softer way out. However, Jesus is fully divine as well, so accepts his fate, knowing salvation for all of mankind hangs in the balance. Only by Christ's sacrifice are we redeemed.

Love demands that we do something difficult for those we love, It demands that we sacrifice greatly to ensure the betterment of heaven for them. We may sacrifice for spouses, children, grandchildren or friends, We may offer up our sacrifices in Lent for greater spiritual benefit for our loved ones and ourselves. Traditionally we offer up sacrifices to the Lord as a streamlining of our souls, helping us to purify ourselves and our loved ones. Will we be like Jesus offering our lives for the lives of those we love? Or will we hesitate when anticipating pain or sacrifice? Will we withdraw or walk all the way to the cross with Christ?

"He who embraces the cross and bears it with patience lightens the weight of the cross. Indeed, the weight itself becomes a consolation; for God abounds with grace to all those who carry the cross with good will in order to please him." St. Alphonsus Liguori

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

El Evangelio de hoy nos invita a caminar con Cristo desde el comienzo de la Semana Santa hasta la última semana de la Cuaresma. Caminamos con Jesús a través de su entrada triunfal en Jerusalén —donde se depositan palmas a sus pies—, a través de su Pasión y de su Resurrección. Qué irónico resulta que la palma del mártir sea un símbolo de victoria espiritual o de triunfo sobre la muerte. Vemos a Nuestro Señor en toda su humanidad: aclamado inicialmente por sus admiradores y, más tarde, brutalmente ejecutado como un criminal. Él es plenamente humano a lo largo de estas pruebas, llegando incluso a pedir al Padre que aparte de Él el cáliz de sufrimiento que le aguardaba. Pero ¿acaso no nos sucede lo mismo a la mayoría de nosotros, que, al enfrentarnos al dolor, la incomodidad y la muerte, imploramos misericordia? El sufrimiento resulta repulsivo para la mayoría de las personas, quienes desean evitarlo a toda costa, optando por el camino más fácil y cómodo. Sin embargo, Jesús es también plenamente divino; por ello, acepta su destino, sabiendo que la salvación de toda la humanidad pende de un hilo. Solo mediante el sacrificio de Cristo somos redimidos. El amor exige que realicemos algo difícil por aquellos a quienes amamos; exige que hagamos grandes sacrificios para asegurarles el bien supremo del Cielo. Podemos sacrificarnos por nuestros cónyuges, hijos, nietos o amigos; podemos ofrecer nuestros sacrificios durante la Cuaresma para procurar un mayor beneficio espiritual tanto para nuestros seres queridos como para nosotros mismos. Tradicionalmente, ofrecemos nuestros sacrificios al Señor como un medio para purificar nuestras almas, ayudándonos así a purificarnos a nosotros mismos y a nuestros seres queridos. ¿Seremos como Jesús, ofreciendo nuestras vidas por las vidas de aquellos a quienes amamos? ¿O vacilaremos ante la perspectiva del dolor o del sacrificio? ¿Nos retiraremos, o caminaremos hasta el final, hasta la cruz, junto a Cristo? «Aquel que abraza la cruz y la lleva con paciencia aligera el peso de la misma. De hecho, el propio peso se convierte en consuelo; pues Dios colma de gracia a todos aquellos que cargan la cruz con buena voluntad, con el fin de agradecerle». San Alfonso María de Liguori
