Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

The Samaritan woman at the well breaks many ancient world boundaries. The story is a remarkable biblical account of Jesus breaking social, gender, ethnic and religious barriers. He reveals his Messiahship to a shunned outcast woman, transforming her life in an instant. Respectable women would draw their water in the early morning or cooler evening, not at the hottest point of the day. This is yet another example of Jesus radical inclusion of outcasts, social misfits and people living on the margins of society. His love transcends all boundaries, offering "living water" (eternal life) to all those willing to abandon their former lives of sin and pursue a Godly life. Recall that Samaria was inhabited by 5 warring tribes with differing pagan gods. The shunned woman has a history of broken marriages and failed relationships, yet is intrigued by a socially superior man speaking to her. This dramatic encounter changes her from a social outcast into an accepted evangelist, becoming a living symbol of grace, redemption and eternal salvation. The Samaritan woman becomes a changed evangelist, converting her whole town through her witness of Christ's mercy. All of us can take a lesson in forgiveness from this story. Our Catechism says "we arrive at contrition when we see the contradiction between God's love and our sin. Then we are sorrowful for our sins, resolve to change our life and place all our hope in God's help." [1490]

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

La mujer samaritana junto al pozo rompe muchas barreras del mundo antiguo. La historia es un extraordinario relato bíblico de Jesús rompiendo barreras sociales, de género, étnicas y religiosas. Revela su mesianismo a una mujer marginada y rechazada, transformando su vida en un instante. Las mujeres respetables solían sacar agua temprano por la mañana o al atardecer, no en el momento más caluroso del día. Este es otro ejemplo de la inclusión radical de Jesús con los marginados, los inadaptados sociales y las personas que viven al margen de la sociedad. Su amor trasciende todas las fronteras, ofreciendo "agua viva" (vida eterna) a todos aquellos dispuestos a abandonar su antigua vida de pecado y buscar una vida piadosa. Recordemos que Samaria estaba habitada por cinco tribus en guerra con diferentes dioses paganos. La mujer rechazada tiene un historial de matrimonios rotos y relaciones fallidas, pero se siente intrigada por un hombre socialmente superior que le habla. Este dramático encuentro la transforma de ser una marginada social a una evangelista aceptada, convirtiéndose en un símbolo viviente de la gracia, la redención y la salvación eterna. La samaritana se convierte en una evangelista transformada, convirtiendo a todo su pueblo gracias a su testimonio de la misericordia de Cristo. Todos podemos aprender una lección de perdón de esta historia. Nuestro Catecismo dice: «Llegamos a la contrición cuando vemos la contradicción entre el amor de Dios y nuestro pecado. Entonces nos arrepentimos de nuestros pecados, decidimos cambiar de vida y ponemos toda nuestra esperanza en la ayuda de Dios». [1490]
