Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Today's gospel might seem like a contradiction rather than a cause for Hope. Often "end times" prophesy predicts a doom and gloom future. Clearly throughout the world we are seeing the persecution of the Christians in Africa, China, and the Middle East. We hear of the "nation against nation, wars, earthquakes, and famines", which seem to be occurring throughout our generation. In our own country at abortion clinics, angry people will complain that they have a right to kill babies if they are inconvenient. We endure these deceived people because of our faith and hope in the Lord. We stand in the gap for those who are unable to speak for themselves. But like the early Christians, Jesus is offering us hope. "By your perseverance you will secure your lives." "Not a hair on your head will be destroyed." How can this be if we are persecuted and martyred for our faith? Jesus means in heaven, we will be fully restored. He is mercifully allowing us extra time to convert, to reconnect to him, to live the best versions of ourselves. Many do not want to wait for this long-promised happiness, rather they want to gain happiness now in this world. Often ignoring God's will and pursuing our own will leads to a derailment of elusive happiness. As Blessed Gueric of Igny said, it is better to become humble with the meek than to share ill-gotten gains with the proud. "The Lord is my share, so I will wait for him."

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

El evangelio de hoy podría parecer una contradicción en lugar de un motivo de esperanza. A menudo, las profecías del fin de los tiempos predicen un futuro sombrío y desolador. Es evidente que en todo el mundo vemos la persecución de los cristianos en África, China y Oriente Medio. Oímos hablar de «guerras, terremotos y hambrunas», que parecen estar ocurriendo en nuestra generación. En nuestro propio país, en las clínicas de aborto, personas enfurecidas se quejan de tener derecho a matar bebés si les resultan incómodos. Soportamos a estas personas engañadas por nuestra fe y esperanza en el Señor. Intercedemos por aquellos que no pueden defenderse. Pero, al igual que a los primeros cristianos, Jesús nos ofrece esperanza: «Con vuestra perseverancia salvaréis vuestras vidas». «Ni un cabello de vuestra cabeza se perderá». ¿Cómo puede ser esto si somos perseguidos y martirizados por nuestra fe? Jesús quiere decir que en el cielo seremos completamente restaurados. Él, misericordiosamente, nos concede más tiempo para convertirnos, para reconectarnos con él, para vivir nuestra mejor versión. Muchos no quieren esperar la felicidad largamente prometida, sino obtenerla ahora en este mundo. A menudo, ignorar la voluntad de Dios y perseguir la nuestra nos lleva a perder la felicidad esquivada. Como dijo el beato Gueric de Igny, es mejor ser humilde con los mansos que compartir las ganancias mal habidas con los orgullosos. «El Señor es mi herencia, por eso esperaré en él».
