Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

The last feast of the Liturgical year is today's Christ the King Sunday. We end the Liturgical year as we began the start of time with Christ's birth A.D. over 2000 years ago. The wise men declared him future King of the universe, following his star and so the greatest story ever told emerges. Jesus fulfilled the prophecies of old by becoming the Anointed one, the Messiah. The title "King of the Jews" is again used on the cross. The inscription was meant as a mockery to label Jesus as just another political dissident. Pilate knew this would taunt the Jews, but it became an unwitting truism. Christians view his title as a true authentic name of his kingship, honoring it as a spiritual moniker, but the secularists use it in disdain. Christ's mission was to rescue Israel and all of mankind. His cross was his throne, demonstrating his gift of self to us and His father. Thorns were his crown. But love reigns with the gift of self. Jesus giving his all for us proves his love over and over. Yet what have we done for him? How have we honored his kingship over us? Our Catechism says the "Kingdom of God begins in those who allow themselves to be transformed by God's love." What have we given up lately? When have we fasted last? Who have we helped today? Do we offer rides to those who in need? Grocery shop for those who are home bound? Visit the sick or feed the homeless? Stick up for those being gossiped about? Offer a kind word to those who are downcast? All those who seek Christ's mercy, peace and truth have access to the Kingdom of God.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

La última fiesta del año litúrgico es hoy, Domingo de Cristo Rey. Concluimos el año litúrgico como lo iniciamos al comienzo de los tiempos, con el nacimiento de Cristo hace más de 2000 años. Los Reyes Magos lo proclamaron futuro Rey del universo, siguiendo su estrella, y así surgió la historia más grandiosa jamás contada. Jesús cumplió las antiguas profecías al convertirse en el Ungido, el Mesías. El título de "Rey de los Judíos" se usa nuevamente en la cruz. La inscripción pretendía ser una burla, tachando a Jesús como un simple disidente político. Pilato sabía que esto provocaría a los judíos, pero se convirtió en una verdad involuntaria. Los cristianos consideran este título como el nombre auténtico de su realeza, honrándolo como un símbolo espiritual, pero los secularistas lo usan con desdén. La misión de Cristo fue rescatar a Israel y a toda la humanidad. Su cruz fue su trono, demostrando su entrega a nosotros y a su Padre. Las espinas fueron su corona. Pero el amor reina con la entrega de sí mismo. Jesús, al entregarlo todo por nosotros, demuestra su amor una y otra vez. Pero ¿qué hemos hecho nosotros por él? ¿Cómo hemos honrado su reinado sobre nosotros? Nuestro Catecismo dice que «el Reino de Dios comienza en aquellos que se dejan transformar por el amor de Dios». ¿A qué hemos renunciado últimamente? ¿Cuándo fue la última vez que ayunamos? ¿A quién hemos ayudado hoy? ¿Ofrecemos transporte a quienes lo necesitan? ¿Hacemos las compras para quienes no pueden salir de casa? ¿Visitamos a los enfermos o alimentamos a las personas sin hogar? ¿Defendemos a quienes son objeto de chismes? ¿Ofrecemos una palabra amable a los abatidos? Todos los que buscan la misericordia, la paz y la verdad de Cristo tienen acceso al Reino de Dios.
