Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

One of life's great secrets is to have an attitude of gratitude. No matter what happens if we accept the good with the bad, we are accepting God's will, which can potentially guide our lives. After Jesus' great gift of healing the ten lepers, only one came back to thank him. How like us, are the other nine? We continue to accept day after day, all that God gives, yet fail to acknowledge him in gratitude. Our very lives, all that we own, all that we do and all that we fail to do are given by God. Yes, missed opportunities in which we fail to act, fail to thank or fail to acknowledge those who help us, are sins of omission! How many times have we failed to say thank you to others? How many times have we failed to say "your kindness means a lot to me?" Our Catechism says that gratitude is love that has been acknowledged. Someone who is grateful turns freely to the Giver of the Good and enters into a new deeper relationship with him. God wishes us to acknowledge his love and even to live our whole lives seeking him. This relationship lasts forever. The righteous seek a real relationship in serving God, and the unrighteous seek self-comfort. When we ask God to show us how to love him more, he will always answer our prayer. Whether we are given crosses or blessings is always God's love manifested. How we respond is our gift back to God. How we serve the Lord is our response to his love. Let us serve him with open hands, giving generously of our time, talent and treasure. We can never do enough to reciprocate God's many gifts to us.
