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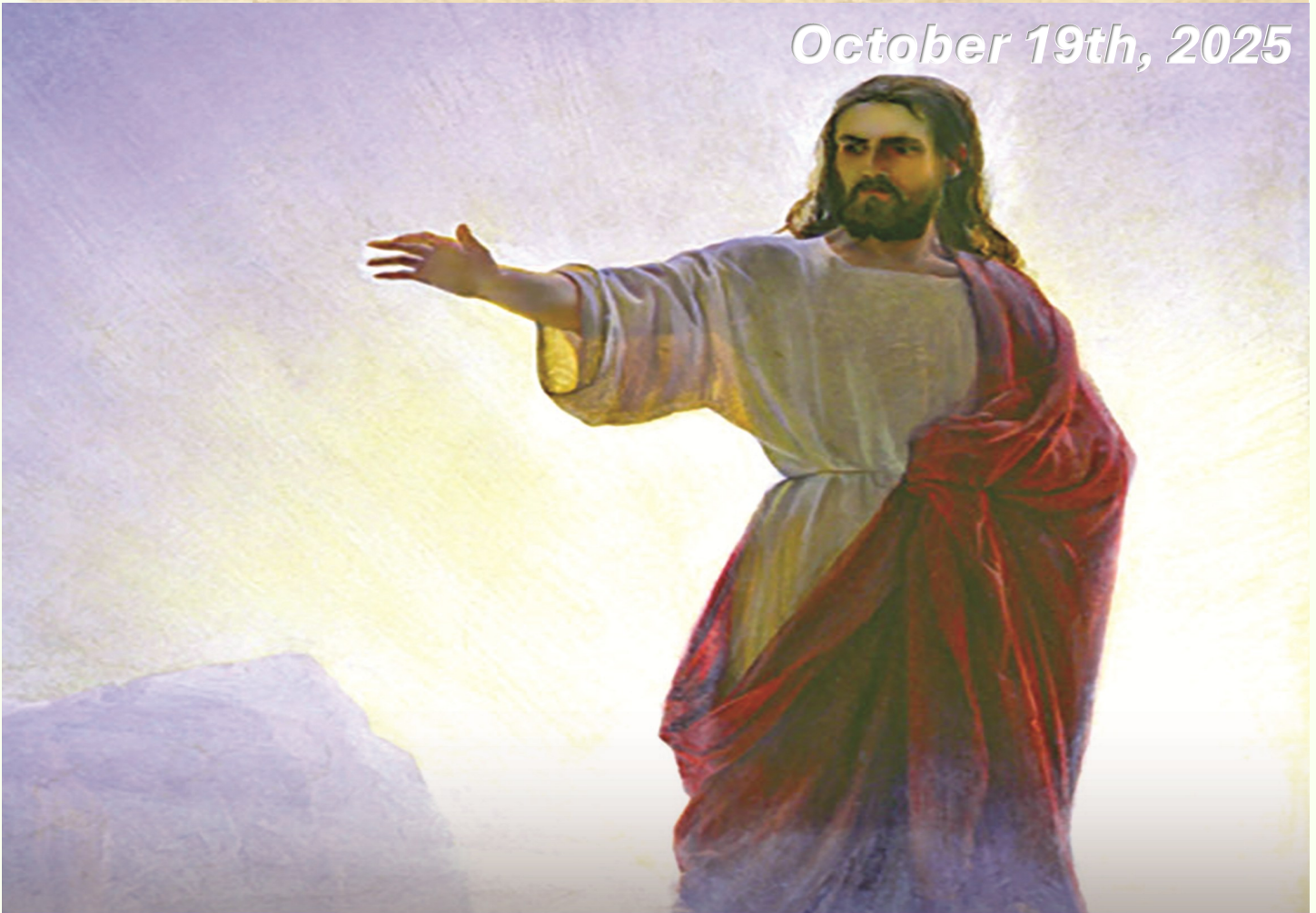

Catechism Corner by Kacey Carey, DRE

Today's gospel is not so much about doggedly pursuing one's will than it is about steadfastly remaining faithful to God's mercy. The parable of the unjust judge finally giving into a persistent woman is a lesson in persistence. Actually, persistence in prayer means continually asking for God's mercy despite no assurance of getting our way. It means to pray without giving up even when answers are not immediately apparent. This practice is encouraged in many faiths to build trust and endurance in God's providence. Jesus knew we would need to guard against discouragement when we didn't see our prayer answered right away. But when we submit to God's timing and persevere in prayer, not giving up, we will eventually reap a harvest. The power to persist in prayer comes from the Holy Spirit through motivation, inspiration and empowerment. After all, how much more will Our Heavenly Father, Jesus and the Holy Spirit grant our requests than an unjust indifferent judge who has no skin in the game? Many of us are steadfast in prayer over decades, persisting in requesting our own and the conversion of beloved family members. Yet we often see no movement on God's part. We may even see increased resistance on the part of family members for whom we are interceding. This testing requires our continued trust and persistence in prayer despite lack of "progress". We know that all prayer is heard by God, but when we trust in God's timing and intervention, we are really doing His will, no matter the outcome. Our Catechism says every Christian life is a story of prayer, one long attempt to achieve even greater union with God. Pray always. Pray unceasingly.

Rincón de Catecismo por Kacey Carey, DRE

El evangelio de hoy no trata tanto sobre la perseverancia en la búsqueda de la propia voluntad, sino sobre la fidelidad a la misericordia de Dios. La parábola del juez injusto que finalmente cedió ante una mujer persistente es una lección de persistencia. En realidad, la persistencia en la oración significa pedir continuamente la misericordia de Dios a pesar de no tener la seguridad de que se logrará. Significa orar sin rendirse, incluso cuando las respuestas no son inmediatas. Esta práctica se fomenta en muchas religiones para generar confianza y perseverancia en la providencia de Dios. Jesús sabía que tendríamos que cuidarnos del desánimo al no ver nuestra oración respondida de inmediato. Pero cuando nos sometemos al tiempo de Dios y perseveramos en la oración, sin rendirnos, finalmente cosecharemos. El poder para persistir en la oración proviene del Espíritu Santo a través de la motivación, la inspiración y el empoderamiento. Después de todo, ¿cuánto más nuestro Padre Celestial, Jesús y el Espíritu Santo concederán nuestras peticiones que un juez injusto e indiferente que no se juega nada? Muchos de nosotros hemos sido firmes en la oración durante décadas, persistiendo en pedir la nuestra y la conversión de nuestros seres queridos. Sin embargo, a menudo no vemos ningún movimiento por parte de Dios. Incluso podemos observar una mayor resistencia por parte de los familiares por quienes intercedemos. Esta prueba requiere nuestra confianza y persistencia constantes en la oración a pesar de la falta de progreso. Sabemos que Dios escucha toda oración, pero cuando confiamos en su tiempo e intervención, realmente estamos haciendo su voluntad, sin importar el resultado. Nuestro Catecismo dice que toda vida cristiana es una historia de oración, un largo intento por alcanzar una unión aún mayor con Dios. Oren siempre. Oren sin cesar.
